Fremont Ross's Malcolm Leake's run in the Division I district tennis tournament came to an end Wednesday at Bowling Green State University.

Leake, a junior, the only member of the Little Giants at the district tournament for the third straight season, defeated Bowling Green's Mitchell Bils 6-0, 6-0 in his first round match. But in round two, Leake lost to Evan Bectel of Toledo St. John's Jesuit, 6-0, 6-1.

Leake, a Greater Buckeye Conference first-team selection, was the No. 3 seed heading into the district tournament, and ended his season for Ross with a singles record of 24-5. He has a three-year record of 65-23, including a singles mark of 56-17.

"I'm proud of Malcolm's district run," Little Giants coach Lisa Wolfe said. "He made it one step further than last year and he earned second team all-district honors.

"He didn't compete in two matches last week because of illness, and came back ready to play. He's had a very successful junior year."
