The postseason ended on a sour note for the Fremont Ross softball team Thursday.

The Little Giants dropped a 6-0 decision to Perrysburg in the Class AAA sectional at Rodger Young Park.

In other tournament games, Clyde and Bellevue won Class AA sectional titles with 1-0 and 22-0 victories over Rossford and Lake, respectively, at Clyde and Tiffin Calvert defeated Fremont St. Joseph Central Catholic 5-1 in the Class A sectional at Bettsville.

At Fremont, winning pitcher Jenny Naumann had three hits including a home run for Perrysburg, 15-5, and Ross committed five errors and left eight runners on base.

"The errors were expensive," Ross Coach Sue Wolf said.

Naumann struck out five and walked two, while losing pitcher Debbie McClure struck out three and did not walk a batter.

"We got people on base, we just didn't get them around," Wolf said. "(Naumann) definitely intimidated us, but we made contact. We just didn't put it together."

Ross slips past Columbian 4-3

Fremont Ross got its tournament season off on the right foot, defeating Tiffin Columbian 4-3 in the first round of the Class AAA girls sectional tournament at Rodger Young Park Monday.

In another tourney game at RYP, Bowling Green trounced Port Clinton 19-6 and in a double-header at New Riegel, St. Joseph Central Catholic split with the Blue Jackets, losing the first game 9-5 but taking the nightcap 6-4.

Columbian, 2-12, led 1-0 after one inning but Ross scored twice in the second to take the lead. After three innings, Columbian led 3-2.

The Little Giants, 6-7, tied the game with a run in the sixth and scored the winning run in the seventh. Rachel Ritter singled in the seventh, stole second and third and scored on Shanell Mo-
