

## 2016 SEASON REVIEW

## **SWIMMING**

### **Ned Reeb Memorial**

Fremont Ross competed at the Ned Reeb Memorial Invitational at Ohio State Saturday. The girls team finished third out of 37 teams, its best finish ever at the event, while the boys finished 17th.

The top finish for the girls was a meet record-setting time of 1:36.65 in the 200 free relay for AnneMarie Moses, Olivia DeRodes, Morgan Waggoner and Meghan Moses. Other top finishers included the second-place 200 medley relay team of MaKennah Fitzgerald, AnneMarie Moses, Waggoner, and Meghan Moses (1:49.02), Meghan Moses' second-place in the 50 free (23.81) and third-place in the 100 free (52.33). Waggoner finished fifth in the 100 fly (58.47) and seventh place in the 100 free (53.05). DeRodes was fifth in the 50 free (24.56) and ninth in the 100 free (54.94). Fitzgerald finished 13th in the 100 backstroke.

Trent Williams finished seventh in both the 50 free (22.04) and 100 free (48.66) while Andrew Evans was 14th in the 100 breaststroke (1:02.15). Tate Williams, Evans, Trent Williams, and Hawk Smith took 12th in the medley relay in 1:41.60. The same foursome also took 13th in the 400 freestyle relay in 3:23.67.

## **Fremont Ross vs. Sylvania Southview**

The Ross boys and girls both came away with wins against Sylvania Southview on Thursday. Girls won, 134-40; Boys won, 95-88.

The Ross boys were led by Trent Williams who won the 50 freestyle (22.17) and the 100 freestyle (48.67), Bo Tong won the 100 butterfly (56.10), Hawk Smith won the 500 freestyle (5:08.85) and Manuel Gutierrez won 1 meter diving with a score of 144.

The girls were led by Meghan Moses who won the 200 freestyle (2:03.06) and the 500 freestyle (5:30.18) alongside Anne Marie Moses who won the 200 individual medley (2:21.57) and the 100 butterfly (1:05.38). Also Morgan Waggoner won the 50 freestyle (24.85) and the 100 backstroke (1:02.86) while Olivia DeRodes won the 100 freestyle (56.62) and the 100 breaststroke (1:14.62); Abby Sweeney won the 1 meter diving with a score of 173.

## **Fremont Ross Swimming**

The Fremont Ross boys swimming team took second place at the Knight Finals. The 200 medley team of Tate Williams, Andrew Evans, Trent Williams and Hawk Smith finished first (1:41.62). Trent Williams was first in the 100 freestyle (48.13) and second in 50 freestyle (22.03). Will Taylor finished fourth in the 500 freestyle (5:07.75).

The Fremont girls took third place. The team of Anne Marie Moses, Olivia DeRodes, Morgan Waggoner and Meghan Moses finished first in the 400 freestyle relay (3:36.54). Meghan Moses was first in the 50 freestyle (24.37) and fourth in the 100 backstroke (1:00.8). The team of Waggoner, Kaity Kelly, MaKennah Fitzgerald and DeRodes finished first in the 200 freestyle relay (1:40.09).

### **Fremont vs. Perrysburg**

Fremont girls won 10 events Thursday to defeat visiting Perrysburg 117-67 and the Fremont boys rallied to win 93-86. Both teams are 3-0 for the Little Giants.

For Fremont in the girls meet, Morgan Waggoner won the 200 freestyle (2:01.99) and the 100 butterfly (1:00.35) and AnneMarie Moses won the 50 freestyle (25.95) and the 100 breaststroke (1:11.38). Other winners were Olivia DeRose, 200 individual medley (2:21.63); Megan Moses, 500 freestyle (5:20.72); and Abby Sweeney, one-meter diving (165.45 points). Fremont also took relay wins in the 200 medley (154.05), 200 freestyle (1:42.34) and the 400 freestyle (3:47.47).

For the Fremont boys, Trent Williams won the 100 butterfly (53.80) and the 100 backstroke (55.96). Other winners were Hawk Smith, 200 individual medley (2:09.19) and Andrew Evans, 100 breaststroke (1:05.96). Fremont won relay events in the 200 medley (1:45.05) and the 400 freestyle (3:27.83).

### **Fremont Ross Tri Meet**

Host Fremont Ross girls defeated Oak Harbor 140-45 and Findlay 115-71 Thursday, while Findlay defeated Oak Harbor 125-60. In the boys competition, Fremont defeated Oak Harbor 126-43 and lost to Findlay 92-84. Findlay defeated Oak Harbor 92-84.

Three girls were double winners for Fremont Ross. Meghan Moses won the 200 individual medley (2:12.91) and the 100 freestyle (53.05); Morgan Waggoner won the 50 freestyle (24.72) and the 100 backstroke (1:00.72); and Olivia DeRodes won the 200 freestyle (1:58.46) and the 500 freestyle (5:20.72). AnneMarie Moses won the 100 butterfly (1:01.53); ). The Little Giants picked up relay wins in the 200 individual medley (1:51.82); the 200 freestyle (1:45.47); and the 400 freestyle (3:44.93).

In the boys competition, Trent Williams won for Fremont in the 50 freestyle (22.05) and the 100 butterfly (53.42). Fremont also won the 200 freestyle relay (1:34.61).

# ROSS CLAIMS WINS OVER MARGARETTA, PC

## Both girls, boys teams log dominating performances

FREMONT - Coming off of winning the Three Rivers Athletic Conference championship on Saturday, Fremont Ross girls coach Tina Moses said her team treated Tuesday's meet with Margaretta and Port Clinton as a fun meet.

Fun or not, it was the Little Giants that were dominant.

In girls action, Ross topped Port Clinton, 124-59 and Margaretta, 147-37. On the boys side, the Little Giants were victorious over Port Clinton, 119-61 and over Margaretta, 133-47.

"Coming off the league championships, we had a lot of girls swimming in their off events tonight," Moses said. "It was Senior Night, so we had some fun with it."

In the other matchups, Port Clinton defeated Margaretta, 90-85 in boys and 139-43 in girls.

The fun started early for the Little Giants' 200 yard medley team of all freshmen — MaKennah Fitzgerald, AnneMarie Moses, Rilee Overmyer, and Olivia DeR-

hodes — topped an all-senior Ross team in a time of 1:55.43. Fitzgerald added a win in 200 free (2:09.06) while DeRhodes won the 200 individual medley in 2:22.82.

"We've been training hard," coach Moses said. "We have leg day every Monday so some of the girls are tired and sore."

For Ross, Morgan Waggoner won the 50 free (24.42) and 100 butterfly (1:00.11) while Moses picked up a victory in the 100 free (56.92) and 100 backstroke (1:05.23).

Meghan Moses was victorious in the 500 free (5:32.36) and 100 backstroke (1:11.35). The team of Waggoner, Meghan Moses, Kaity Kelly, and Alaina Klingman won the 400 free relay in 3:48.77.

"All of our seniors are important to us," coach Moses said. "With swimming off events, they didn't really stand out like they did on Saturday."

For Port Clinton, Kenzie Pluto won the diving with a score of 209.10 and the relay team of Taylor Steyer, Bryanna Barr, Gabby Sharkey, and Lauren Shaw won the 200
