1994 Fremont Ross Cross Country Team

The 1994 Fremont Ross cross-country team ran to fame in the Ohio High School State Cross Country Meet, finishing second to Cleveland St. Ignatius.

It was the first Ross boys' team to compete as a team in the state meet, earning an entry with a third-place finish in the Division I Regional Meet.

The seven members of the team that ran in the state meet were Jeremiah Wagner, Jeremiah Smith, Dan Snyder, Doug Jibilian, Kurt Snyder, Clint Hill, and Jake Smith.

Wagner was 11th in the state meet, finishing in 16 minutes and 14 seconds while earning first team All-Ohio honors. He set the Ross school record with a 15:51 clocking during the season.

Jeremiah Smith earned second team honors with a 24th place finish in the state meet. As a junior, he had earned second team honors with a 16th place finish.

Other finishes in the state meet that helped the Little Giants notch their historic team finish were Dane Snyder (47th), Jibilian (80th), Kurt Snyder (85th), Hill (111th), and Jake Smith (145th).

Other team achievements in 1994 included third in the Great Lakes League Meet, second in the Division I District Meet and third in the Division I Regional Meet.
