Little Giants third in GLL

HURON — Leon Garza and Doug Garvey each shot an 84 to lift Fremont Ross to a third place finish at the Great Lakes League Tournament at Saw Mill in Huron.

Toledo Whitmer won the meet with a 334, followed by Bedford with a 336 and Ross with a 341.

The 18th hole may have cost the Little Giants a chance at the title.

"We three-putted quite a bit," said coach Denny Ritchie. "On the last hole, we lost eight shots, and we only finished seven back."

Kyle Peck shot an 86, to join Garza and Garvey on the all-GLL second team.

Jay Farrell fired an 87 and Matt Bauer shot a 95 for the Little Giants.

Findlay placed fourth with a 347, Clay was fifth with a 358, Fostoria placed sixth with a 366 and Sandusky came in seventh with a 385.

Whitmer's Matt Smith shot a 78 to earn medalist honors. He was joined on the all-GLL first team by Ron Straight and Matt Adamski of Bedford, Dave Girral of Whitmer and Findlay's Ernie Chamberlain.

"This is the toughest course we've played on," Ritchie said. "The greens were fast. A lot of teams three-putted, not just us."

"We were pleased with the way the team performed."
