

Ross Harriers Run In Toledo Tomorrow

Tomorrow Coach Don Hirschberger will take his Ross high cross country team to Toledo where, on the Ottawa Hills course, they will compete in the district scholastic meet against DeVilbiss, Central Catholic, Scott, Waite and Woodward of Toledo; Mansfield, Findlay, Old Fort and Sandusky.

Those runners making the trip are Jerry Larkins, Lamar Hoffman, Bill Heflinger, Dick Schell, Jim Sevitts, Fred Stetzel and Lamar Whysong.

Each school will run seven men, but only the first five can figure in the scoring. Winners will qualify for the state meet to be held in Mansfield later.

Cross Country District Meet Is Won By Waite

Toledo Waite won the Toledo district high school 'cross-country meet on the Ottawa Hills course in Toledo Saturday with a total of 69 points. Fremont Ross was last of the seven schools competing with 123 points.

Gernhauer of Toledo Central Catholic won the individual title, negotiating the two-mile course in 10 minutes and 33 seconds. Dick Larkins of Ross was 13th among the individuals, and the first Ross man across the tape, running the distance in 11:34.

The order of the finish by teams and their points: Toledo Waite, 69; Toledo Woodward, 74; Mansfield, 84; Old Fort, 87; Toledo DeVilbiss, 109; Toledo Central Catholic, 110; Fremont Ross, 123.

Ross will meet Toledo Central Catholic in a dual meet here Tuesday afternoon and will have another dual engagement, with Findlay, Thursday afternoon. Races will begin about 4 p. m. each day.
