HIGH SCHOOL SWIMMING

Napoleon sweeps GBC meet

FREMONT — The Fremont Ross boys fought their way to a second place finish and 387 points against a bigger, deeper Napoleon (469) team in this year's Greater Buckeye Conference Championships Saturday at the Fremont Natatorium.

In the girls portion, the Little Giants were third with 298 points behind Napoleon (401) and Findlay (396).

"They swam a good meet, with a lot of personal best times," said coach Phil Moran. "We really weren't sure what to expect

because the weather has messed up our practice routine, and swimmers generally don't take kindly to changes in their routines."

Ross continued to dominate in the boys relays, grabbing first in both the 200 and 400 freestyles. Jordan Beck, Brian Hoelzle, Dexter Foos and Alex Hoffman slipped past Napoleon 1:30.41-1:30.96 in the 200. It was just that close in the 400, with Beck, Kyle Wasserman, Hoffman and Foos swimming a 3:21.28 over Sandusky's 3:21.62.

Fremont's medley relay, a tough relay to put together because it requires a

strong swimmer in every stroke, is coming around this season. Erick White, Wasserman, Hoelzle and Beck were just off the heals of Napoleon, with a 1:43.61 to Napoleon's 1:42.26.

"When it comes to finishing, the guys just know how to get there," said Moran. "As hard as we've been practicing, we were very pleased with how they brought it home. It bodes well for the run-up to the state meet."

The Little Giants had their share of top individual finishes as well.

Beck won the 50-yard free with Hoelzle in for

fourth. Hoffman was third in the 200-yard and fourth in the 100-yard freestyles. Mike Yuhas was second in the grueling 500 freestyle, with Tom Hohman fifth. Foos and White went 2-4 in the 100 backstroke. Wasserman, White and Hohman grabbed a handful of team points with their 1-3-4 finish in the 100 butterfly. Wasserman was also second in the 200-yard individual medley, with Foos third and Yuhas fifth.

"The kids are swimming some of the best times we've seen in season, not tapered," said Moran.

"They really aren't supposed to be swimming this fast, considering how hard we are pushing them in practice, so we feel pretty good about what's to come."

The Napoleon girls proved to be as strong and deep as the Wildcats' boy's team, winning five individual and two relay events.

Ross's Taylor Waggoner continued her winning ways, taking first in the 100 butterfly by over four seconds with a 1:01.87. Teammate Courtney Gabel was fifth in the event.

In what's sure to be a showdown at the end of the season, Waggoner and Napoleon's Erika Vocke fought to the end in the 200 freestyle, with Vocke finishing first at 2:02.04 to Waggoner's 2:02.25. Gabel was also second in the 50 freestyle, and Alyssa Moyer third in the 100 backstroke.

Divers Jordyn Gallagher and Brittany Stout added to the all important team total with their first and third place finishes in diving — 187.10 and 186.5 points, respectively.

Two underclassmen are making waves for the Little Giants this season. Sammil Miller was fifth in the 50 freestyle, and fifth in the 100 freestyle. Danielle Minier was second in the 100 breaststroke. Both Miller and Minier were on the two second-place finishing Little Giants' relay teams.

Gabel, Miller, Christi Meggitt and Waggoner finished half a second ahead of Sandusky for second in the 200 freestyle relay. Minier, Waggoner, Gabel and Meggitt finished just a second behind Napoleon for second in the 200 medley relay.
