

Findlay Trips Ross Nine 9-6

FINDLAY — A six-run explosion in the bottom of the fifth inning provided Findlay a come-from-behind baseball victory over Ross high, 9-6, here Friday.

Ross led 6-3 going into the last of the fifth but Findlay got to Fremont starter John Level for five runs and reliever Gary Bierly for one before the inning ended. The Trojans bunched singles by Mains, Bowman and Highsmith plus three walks and a couple of wild pitches for their big inning.

Ross picked up four runs in the third inning on only one hit, a single by Bierly. A single by Doug Gallagher drove in another run in the fourth. Bierly's triple plated Level who had singled in the top of the fifth.

Bierly continues his solid hitting for Coach Lawrence Doren's nine, getting 2 hits in 2 at bats and driving in three runs.

Level was the losing hurler and Pirschell the winner. Highsmith led Findlay at bat with two for three.

Ross is now 3-2 for the season.

Bierly Allows Macomber One Hit In 1-0 Contest

Another nifty pitching performance was turned in by a Fremont Ross hurler, second in two days, when Gary Bierly one-hit visiting Toledo Macomber Friday at Anderson Field.

Ross won the game 1-0, fifth victory in seven starts, the same margin by which the Little Giants defeated Huron Thursday in the Class AA sectional at Bellevue when Doug Gallagher pitched a no-hit game.

Bierly struck out four and walked four in recording his third pitching triumph without a loss and loser Szenderski of Macomber fanned six, walked only one.

Ross had men on base in every inning, collecting at least one hit in every frame except the fifth when Steve Cecil walked. But until the last of the sixth inning, the hits didn't produce a run.

In Ross high's sixth, Gallagher singled after one out and went to second on a wild pitch. A scratch single by Chuck Houdeshell put Gallagher on third and another single by Mark Walter plated Gallagher with the only run of the contest.

Ross collected eight singles in the game, two by Houdeshell.

Next outing for Coach Lawrence Doren's Ross high nine will be against Clyde Tuesday, 3:30 p. m., at Bellevue in the sectional tournament.
