## Swimming

# Ickes wins twice in sectional

OAK HARBOR — Mindy Ickes, who won two events in the Northwest Ohio Section III swimming meet Saturday at Oak Harbor High School, leads the Fremont Ross contingent to the district meet this week.

The Ross girls finished second in the sectional with 321 points. The Aqua Giants trailed Sandusky Perkins, who had 360, and Oak Harbor was third with 309.

The Ross boys finished fifth with 245 points behind champion Perkins' 439. Oak Harbor was second with 312 1/2.

The district meet is Thursday, Friday and Saturday at the Bowling Green State University Student Recreation Center. The district events are comprised of the top three finishers in each event at the sectional plus at-large entrants based on times in the three Northwest Ohio sectionals.

Ickes' two wins gave Ross three in the competition after Jennifer Newman won the diving event on Friday.

Ickes set a sectional meet record in the 200-yard individual medley, finishing in two minutes, 18.22 seconds. That broke her own mark of 2:19.77 set last year. Ickes also won the 100 breaststroke in 1:11.34.

Annie Mears (25.94) was second and Molly O'Connor (26.06) third in the 50 freestyle for Ross. The two reversed spots in the 100 freestyle with O'Connor (56.58) second and Mears (57.96) third.

Addie Baker was runner-up in the 500 freestyle in 5:46.43 for the Aqua Giants, and the Ross 200 freestyle relay of O'Connor, Ickes, Baker and Mears was second in 1:47.4. The same team finished third in the 200-yard medley relay in 1:59.27.

Oak Harbor's girls relays teams won three events, setting records in three of them.

The Rockets were first in the medley relay in a record 1:58.26. Oak Harbor also won the 200 freestyle relay in a record 1:44.14 and the 400 freestyle relay in 3:49.79.

In individual events, Andrea Lange won the 50 freestyle in 25.92 for the Rockets, Amy Tabbert took first in the butterfly in 1:04.49 — a sectional record.

Monica Tabbert of Oak Harbor was second and Brooke Weis third in the individual medley in 2:22.91 and 2:29.58, respectively. On Friday, Ellyn Vreeland was second in diving.

In the boys meet, Hans Schmidlin of Ross won the 100 freestyle in 50.53 and Erick Luse was third in the butterfly in 1:00.35.

Oak Harbor's medley relay won in a record 1:44.51 and the 200 freestyle relay set another sectional record, winning in 1:31.48. The Rockets' 400 freestyle relay added another first in 3:25.62.

Andy Jenkins was first in 22.85 and Brian Pointer second in 22.92 in the 50 freestyle for the Rockets.
