ROSS GOLFERS TOP SANDUSKY

Coach Ed Gabel's Ross high golf team opened its season with a 10½ to 5½ victory over Sandusky high's divot-diggers at the Fremont Golf Club Saturday morning. Clarence Paulus, Don Greenman and Johnny Ruland paced the Little Giants to victory with four, three and a half, and three points respectively in their 18-hole matches.

Top match was the one between Greenman and Jack Quilter of Sandusky, with the former turning in an 84 card and the Blue Streak scoring 87. Ruland fired 94 in his duel with Bob Witter and Paulus took 95 as he beat John Wenehler.

Tom Hedges, Sandusky aquatic star, topped Jack Carroll, Ross high's cage captain-elect, by four points. Carroll had a 97 score. The Little Giant golfers travel to Bowling Green this Saturday to face the Bobcat tee team.
