Ross Golfers Place Third In Buckeye

MARION — Led by Keith Gibbs, who was third low medalist at 80 strokes, Fremont Ross golf team surprised with a strong third place in the Buckeye Conference golf tournament. The tournament was contested over the par 35-35-70 Marion Country Club course Monday.

The team championship was won by the host Marion club with a 321-stroke total. Elyria finished second at 339, followed by Ross, 349. Findlay and Mansfield tied for fourth with 357 strokes, while Sandusky was last at 358.

Elyria's Bill Freeman was medalist with a six-over-par 76. Tod Newman of Marion was second with 78, followed by Gibbs.

Individual scores for the four Ross competitors in the tournament were: Gibbs, 37-43-80; John Decker, 44-45-89; Bob Van Hook, 47-48-95; Craig Wright, 41-44-85.
