Locals discover their state seeds, qualifying fate

Fremont Ross's Taylor Waggoner is the fifth seed in the 100-yard butterfly at 56.68 seconds and 15th in the 200 freestyle at 1:54.74 for the Division I state meet in Canton.

Waggoner, Sammi Miller, Laura Duncan and Megan Hawk are the third seed in the 200 freestyle relay at 1:37.36 and 15th seed in the 400 freestyle relay at 3:36.69.

Waggoner captured district titles in the 100 butterfly and 200 freestyle this season while the 200 and 400 freestyle relays were also first.

Duncan is the 22nd seed in the 100 breaststroke at 1:07.40 and Miller is the 23rd seed in the 50 freestyle at 24.44.

Alex Hoffman is the 14th seed in the 100 butterfly at 52.41 and 24th seed in the 200 freestyle at 1:44.35

for the boys. Hoffman earned a district title in the 100 butterfly.

Hoffman, Keith Wasserman, Luke Wilhelm and Eric Yuhas are the 22nd seed in the 200 freestyle relay at 1:29.16.

DIVISION II

Four Rockets qualify to Canton

Oak Harbor's Danielle Franck is the 19th seed in the 100 breaststroke (1:08.02) for the Division II state meet.

The Rockets' Bethany McNutt, Marlee Carpenter, Allie Dombrowsky and Franck are the 21st seed in the 200 medley relay at 1:54.41.

Margaretta's Sydney Craig is the 13th seed in the 50 freestyle at 24.59.

The Polar Bears' Tyler Beekman is the 16th seed in the diving competition.
