Fremont Ross met Shelby at 4 p. m., today in Mansfield in the semifinal round of the Mansfield Class AA baseball sectional tournament.

In the other semifinal, Ashland and Mansfield clashed at 2 p. m. Final game will be at 3 p. m. tomorrow with the winner advancing to the Marion District.

Ross outsted Mansfield Madison yesterday 2-0 on the one-hit pitching of lefty Doug Gallagher. Ashland eliminated Willard in Wednesday's first game.

The winning runs for Ross were scored in the first inning, both unearned. Mark Walter was safe on a dropped fly ball by the Madison first baseman, Dale Entenmann also reaching base on a dropped throw by the same opposing player. Both scored when the Madison second baseman fumbled Chuck Houdeschell's grounder.

That was the end of the scoring.

Gallagher, in firing his one-hitter, struck out 15, walked 2 Chelski of Madison got their only hit, a single in the seventh and final inning. Selley, Madison pitcher, was touched for 4 Ross hits, one a double by Roger Mann. Selley fanned 6, walked 2.

Houdeschell, moved up to fourth in the Ross batting order because of his batting prowess, came through with two singles yesterday. John Level got the other Ross hit, a single.

Either Al Price or Level was expected to be on the mound today as Ross tried to improve on its 1-3 season record.

John Level, junior righthander, allowed Shelby only three hits but two of them came in the sixth inning to account for the lone run of the game. Pitcher Schiffer led off with a single and, with two out, scored on a single by second baseman Sifferline.

Level struck out 12 and walked 3; Schiffer fanned 11 and passed 2.
