Ross Third, Clyde Second In District Run

SANDUSKY — Clyde qualified its entire team for the regional meet and Ross finished third in the district cross country meet held Saturday at Mills Creek golf course. Clyde finished second behind district champion Sandusky. The finish was the reversal of a regular season dual meet won by Clyde.

John Jefferson, Sandusky, entered the finish chute first with a 10:24 clocking for the two-mile course.

Order of team finish was Sandusky, 28; Clyde, 49; Fremont Ross, 92; Norwalk 135; Lake, 139; Genoa, 173; Clay, 177; Port Clinton, 202. The top 10 individuals and top two teams advance to the regional run.

Chris Rodriguez, Clyde, was second in a 10:29 clocking. Other Clyde point winners were Rich Dickman, sixth, 10:44; Joe Ramirez, ninth, 11:02; Rudy McGirt, 13th, 11:10, and Tony Rodriguez, 19th, 11:24.

Finish of runners for Ross was Chuck Cheek, 15th, 11:13; Chuck Boskovich, 17th, 11:15; Rex Damschroder, 18th, 11:22; Tom Hilt, 20th, 11:25; Mel Huffman, 22nd, 11:27; Mike Geib, 26th, 11:34; Bob Ballenger, 28th, 11:40. Runners finishing 11th through 20th received silver medals.
