Little Giants 5th at Heart of Ohio Invite

MECHANICSBURG – Coach Chad Hetrick took his band of Little Giant wrestlers to Mechanicsburg last weekend to take part in the 15-team Heart of Ohio Invitational.

The Little Giants had a champion in the 120 lbs. weight class where sophomore veteran Bryce Estep defeated Shawnee's Grant Driskill with a 15-0 technical fall.

The 106 lbs. class, the 126 lbs. and 165 lbs. saw Little Giant wrestlers finish in third. At 106 was freshman Aidan Autullo defeat Mechanicsburg's Nolan Fraley with a fall at 2:46 for a third-place finish. At 126 lbs. senior Gage Ross defeated Philip Hash of River Valley with a 2-0 decision for his third-place finish. At 165 lbs. was Brody Barth who got his third-place finish when he took care of Matthew Cox of Kenton Ridge with a 7-2 decision.

Finishing fifth at 215 lbs. was senior Mason Villarreal. Villarreal defeated Brady Hauf of Shawnee with a fall at the 3:52 mark.

The Little Giants had two sixth place finishers during the event. Dayne Howey at 175 lbs. defeated Carter Rockenbaugh of Mechanicsburg to pick up his sixth-place finish with a fall in 4:12.

At 190 lbs. Rhein Hottinger settled for sixth place when he was defeated by Stephen Lehr of Miami Trace with an 8-4 decision.

Other Fremont Ross placers was Stephen Reiter (7th place, 132 lbs.), Zebediah Zucker (7th place 285 lbs.), Owen Shanahan (9th place 144 lbs.), and Cade Reineck (15th place, 150 lbs.)

Fremont Ross finished the tournament placing fifth out of the 15 team field with 159.0 points. Miami Trace won the championship scoring 248.0.

The Little Giant wrestlers are back in action at the "Purple Pit" Wednesday evening when they play host to the Clyde Fliers.
