

Coach says Aqua Giants swim excitedly

First-year coach Ryan Roshong has noticed an abundance of fresh excitement and enthusiasm among the Fremont Ross Aqua Giants.

"They're very fired up this year," Roshong says, "and they're working very, very hard. They're just excited about this year."

Roshong is a graduate of Sandusky Perkins high school and Wright State University in Dayton.

"The guys are looking stronger right now," Roshong said, "particularly in the distance freestyle events, but our girls are

comming along real well."

Roshong said the 200-meter individual medley and 100 breaststroke, with senior Chris Schaaf; and the 100 butterfly, with Francisco Rosito, should be the boys' strongest events.

Roshong said he's counting on the senior leadership of Aaron King and Dave Zinkand along with the junior tenacity of Lee Huffman and Nathan Cox to further help the boys.

King will be used in the sprint freestyles, Cox will help fill out the distance

freestyles and Huffman will be used in a variety of events.

Junior Ryan Wing will be strong in the 200 and 500 distance freestyle swims, Roshong said.

For the girls, Roshong said sophomore Addie Baker will be competitive in the 200 IM and 100 backstroke, Tracy Baker swims the 500 and 200 distance freestyle events and sophomore Ronelle Marr "looks strong in the 100 fly."

"They're just very even all around after that," Roshong said. "There's not any weak spots, but I don't have any real standouts right now."

Heather Mears, a junior, should help out

in the breaststroke and fly. Senior Shannon Vaffis will swim distance freestyle, and senior Angie Sprenger's strength in the 100 fly and sprint freestyles will be utilized.

"Those are our major strengths right there," Roshong said. "Everybody else is right behind. We should have a good amount of depth and hopefully we'll be out-touching for the thirds and the fourths."

As far as the postseason goes, Roshong said his goal is to be in the top two or three at sectionals.

The Aqua Giant begin their season Wednesday at the Tiffin YMCA against Calvert.

Aqua Giants open with victories

TIFFIN — Fremont Ross opened the season swimmingly Wednesday as the Aqua Giants topped Tiffin Calvert twice.

The Ross boys beat the Senecas 125-37 at the Tiffin YMCA, while the girls team was victorious 127-42.

"For our first meet, we swam really, really well," Ross coach Ryan Roshong said. "We swam as well or better than I had hoped.

"Some of the freshmen boys did a nice job filling in the gaps, picking up third places and fourth places.

"The girls swam great. I had a couple girls go personal bests or swim times better times than they did at the beginning of last season."

Ross won every event in both meets.

Ryan Wing, Chris Schaaf and David Zinkand each won two individual events for the boys; and foreign exchange students Tilko Mueller of Germany and Fransisco Rosito of Brazil showed how important they will be to the Aqua Giants this year.

"They help to round off the team in that everyone knows what they are swimming," Roshong said. "It helps to clarify things and everyone is in place."

Roshong said by season's end, the swimmers will have no doubt what their best event is.

Mueller swims all of the freestyle events for Ross, while Rosito specializes in the butterfly and can fill in anywhere from the 50 to the 500 freestyle.

Tracie Baker, Addie Baker and Beth Brudzinski each won three individual events for the Ross girls.

"Of course we had a few standouts, but everyone contributed and we had some great efforts by our sophomores (including Tuesday Miller and Karen Wonderly)," Roshong said.



SANDUSKY — The Fremont Ross boys swimming and diving team fell to 5-2 in dual meets Wednesday, while the Ross girls slipped to 4-3.

Sandusky Perkins defeated Ross 99-86 in the boys meet, and the Pirates topped the Aqua Giants 100-85 in the girls meet.

"I made some mistakes at the front end of the (boys) meet. I should have switched some people around," Ross coach Ryan Roshong said. "I underestimated Perkins in the early part of the meet. We swam really well in the back end of the meet, but

they had more depth in the front. "I made some changes along the way, but it was a little too late."

In the girls meet, Perkins simply matched up well against

Ross.

"Perkins had some really strong girls," Roshong said. "They matched up with our strengths, and they beat our strengths."

"We lost a few key events and their second and third swimmers beat our second and third swimmers."

Ross swept the diving competition, with Leslie Hasselbach and Jennifer Newman finishing 1-2 in the girls event.

Hasselbach, who holds the Ross school record of 231.7 points, compiled the third highest total of her career — 222.9.

Brian Thatcher won the boys

diving with 156.15 points.

Chris Schaaf was a double winner for the Aqua Giants, taking first in the individual medley and the butterfly.

Other winners were Tilko Mueller (50 freestyle), Francisco Rosito (butterfly), Ryan Wing (500 freestyle) and the 200 free relay team of Lee Huffman, Mueller, Jimmy Sabetto and Jerry Dahms.

The girls 200 free relay squad of Abby Held, Ronelle Mahr, Angie Sprenger and Tracie Baker also was victorious.

Sprenger also won the 100 freestyle, and Shannon Vaffis took first in the 50 freestyle.

Ross swimmers sink Sandusky

The Fremont Ross girls won the final seven events to defeat Sandusky 90-70 and the Ross Aqua Giant boys got a pair of victories each from Francisco Rosito and Chris Schaaf to turn back the Blue Streaks 101-69.

The Ross girls are 7-4 and the boys 8-3.

Tracy Baker won the 200 and 500 freestyles and swam on the winning 200 and 400 freestyle relays for the Ross girls.

Rosito won the 200 free and the 100 butterfly while Schaaf was first in the 50 free and 100 breaststroke. Both swam on the winning 400 free relay team.

Hasselbach sets Ross diving record


Fremont Ross diver Leslie Hasselbach bettered her own school record with 242½ points in the Aqua Giants' swimming and diving meet at Defiance Saturday. The old record was 231.7 points.

Hasselbach, a junior, has set the school mark three times this season after bettering it twice a year ago. She easily won the competition Saturday, finishing ahead of teammate Jennifer Newman, who compiled 205.05 points.

In boys diving, Brian Thatcher took first place with 186.4 points — his personal best for this season. The sophomore finished in front of Defiance's Aaron Moore, who had 110.6 points.

Both Ross swimming and diving teams won the meet, taking the boys meet 123-38 and winning the girls competition 93-86.

Winning two events for the Aqua Giants were Chris Schaaf (200 individual medley and the 100 breaststroke), Tracie Baker (200 and 500 freestyle) and Addie Baker (100 butterfly and the 100 backstroke).

picked up from there, turning in winning notes in eight of the final 10 events including 1-2 sweeps in six of them.


Tracy Baker won her specialties, the 200 and 500 freestyle events, taking the former in two minutes, 7.07 seconds and the latter in 5:41.08.
