eighth in the regional and didn't qualify for the state competition.

Toledo DeVilbiss paced by its duo of Jeff Schnell and Walt Churchill, who finished first and second, won the AAA division. DeVilbiss recorded 115 points, 30 less than Austintown Fitch, which was the second place finisher.

In Class A, Kent State easily won the team championship. The winners registered only 33 points compared to 63 for second place Georgetown.

Two area boys competed on an individual basis in the open division. Tony Hernandez of

Woodmore was 15th and Al Widman of Fremont Ross placed 46th. A total of 125 runners competed in the open bracket, which was won by Mike Burley of Berea, who was timed in 9:44.2.

Hernandez was clocked in 10:07. Widman's time was 10:25. Boys from all three classes, who didn't compete with their team, were bracketed in the open division.

This was the first year the meeting was run in three divisions. Previously, competition was held in only two classes.
