Ross, Oak Harbor, Bellevue all shoot to reclaim crowns

Outlook: The Little Giants are looking to relive last year's GLL championship, the first in school history. Like last year, Ross must get past the team that handed it a dual-meet defeat during the regular season. Last year it was Fostoria; this year it's Findlay. The Trojans sneaked past the Little Giants, 38-37, early in the season and went unbeaten through the league slate. Ross will ride its defending champion in Gutschalk, who must navigate a loaded 140-pound class, and top wrestlers Legg and Davis.

Coach's quote: "I'm excited. I think the boys can repeat as champions. If we win the tournament, we'll win the league. But it will be close. The kids are confident they can win it. I am, too." — **Grover Dowell, Ross.**

Nate Jenkins (171) and Corey Hessick (189) came in fourth.

Ross second at GLL

SANDUSKY — Andrew Legg and Zac Brunner won individual championships Saturday, but the Fremont Ross wrestlers could not defend their Great Lakes League title.

The Little Giants scored 141 points, 14 fewer than champion Findlay. The Trojans defeated Ross during a regular-season dual meet.

Legg claimed an 8-5 decision over Eric Duenke of Findlay for the 189-pound title. Brunner pinned Sandusky's Andrew Montgomery in one minute, 26 seconds, for the title at 103 pounds.

Austin Earle (152), Chris Kayser (215)

and Jarrod Pena (275) each finished second for Ross.

Little Giants Brock Davis (125) and Jake Gutschalk (140) finished third. Jaime Mendoza (112), Sam Krueger (119), Tim Freeman (130), Myles Porter (160) and Brandon Wolf (171) came in fourth.

Ross is at the Division I sectional on Friday and Saturday at Toledo Rogers High School.
