# Ross Seeks Buckeye Loop Wrestling Title

Fremont Ross' wrestling squad will go after the Buckeye Conference mat crown Saturday in Elyria, starting at 2 p.m. Ross finished second a year ago to the Pioneers.

Teams in the BC with wrestling squads are Fremont, Elyria, Findlay, Sandusky and Mansfield. Elyria is the team to beat but Coaches Mal Mackey and Pete Michaels rate Findlay and Mansfield tough in various weights.

Fremont will be minus one of its veteran wrestlers as Ralph

Starr, 112-pounder, had to give up the sport because of a congenital vertebra defect. The diagnosis was only recently discovered.

Curt Joseph is Ross' returning winner of a conference title, having won the 103-pound championship last season. This year, however, Joseph is vying in the 120-pound weight.

Mackey welcomes the return to form of Felix Palomo, who, although working out all year, has been kept out of meet action because of a shoulder injury. Palomo probably will go in the 165-pound division if he can make the weight.


## Sports In Brief

## **Ross' Gary Meggitt, Larry Kelly Capture Buckeye Mat Crowns**

Gary Meggitt and Larry Kelly of Fremont Ross were crowned champions Saturday night of their respective divisions in the Buckeye Conference wrestling tournament held at Elyria.

Host Elyria walked off with its second consecutive mat title. Elyria had 96 points, Mansfield 64, Fremont 63, Findlay 61 and Sandusky 23. Last season, the Pioneers won nine of 11 first places.

Meggitt opened the final round of the tourney with a victory over Hoovler of Mansfield in the 103-pound division. Kelly earned his title in the 127-pound weight by

defeating Mantel of Findlay.

Results of other Ross wrestlers in the meet are as follows: Glen Haas had a second in the 138-pound class, Curt Joseph (120), Jim Haas (154), Bill Wagner (175) and Felix Palomo (165) all finished second. Bob Bundshuh had a fourth place in the 145-pound division.
