

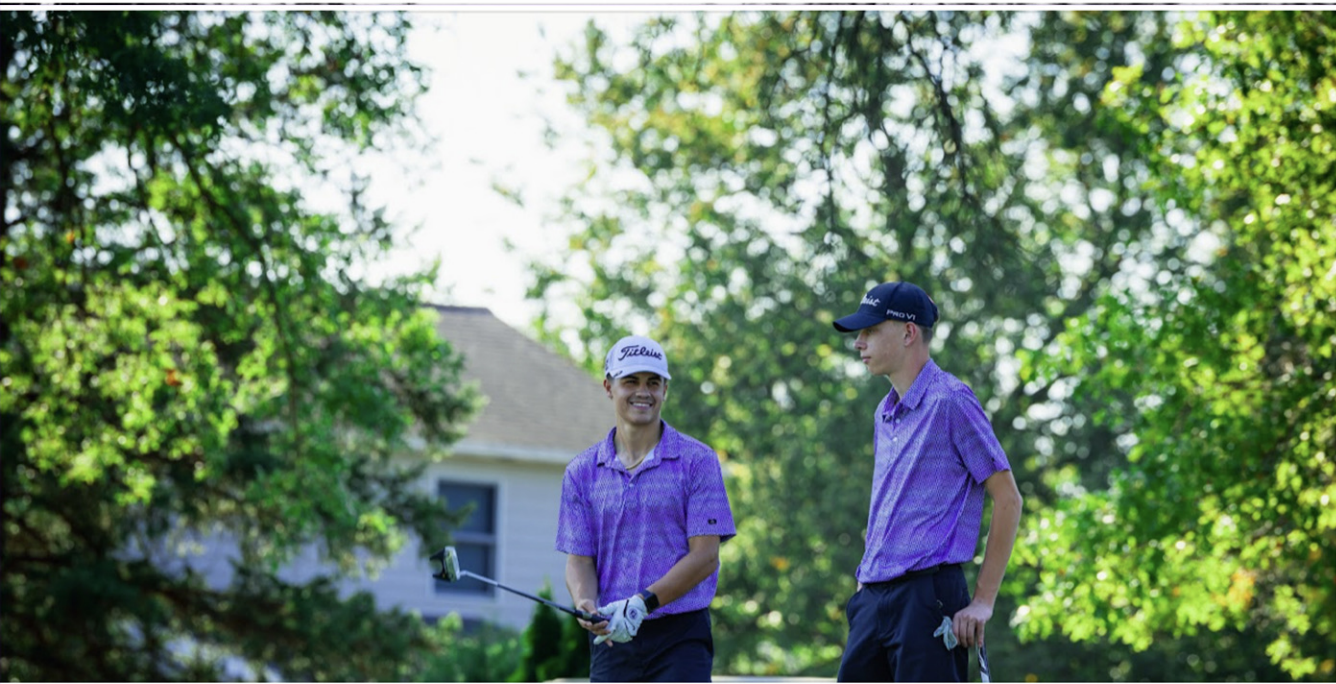
Ross Boys Golf Places Fourth at NLL Championships...

The Fremont Ross boys golf team turned in a solid performance Thursday at the Northern Lakes League Championships, finishing fourth in the Cardinal Division with a team score of 343 at Eagles Landing.

Leading the way for the Little Giants was junior Quinn Wolf, who earned First Team All-Conference honors with a steady round of 82. Wolf's consistency set the tone for Ross and capped off an impressive showing for him on the season.

Right behind Wolf was teammate Grady Kelly, who carded an 83 to keep Ross in the hunt throughout the day. Max Durnwald contributed an 88, while Braylon Jordan followed closely with a 90. Rounding out the Little Giants' scoring were Aiden Autullo with a 92 and Brandon Fry at 93.
