## Tennis Results

Looking into the tennis results, Coach Jack Decker's doubles team of Charles Montgomery and Tom Hite won its first two matches but lost out in the quarter-finals.

First match saw the Ross team post a 6-4, 6-2, win over Del Yoder and Bob Frost, of Bellevue; and in the second outing, the locals topped Toledo Scott's Fitz and Rynders by scores of 7-5 and 7-5.

In the quarter-finals, though, Mansfield's crack doubles team of John Klein and Gordon Smith posted a 6-3, 6-2 win over Fremont, and they ended further contention.

Tom Adkins, also of the Little Giant netters, lost in a singles match with Mansfield's Roth by scores of 6-1 and 6-4.
