Fremont Ross defeats Perkins at home on Tuesday

Both the Fremont Ross boys and girls teams defeated Perkins on Tuesday. The girls won 112-73 while the boys won 119.5-63.5.

The Fremont Ross girls relay teams paved the way with wins by the teams of MaKennah Fitzgerald, Shelby Level, Rilee Overmyer and Ellie Stover (2:00.84) in the 200 yard medley relay and Level, Alexis Prenzlin, Kaity Kelly and Anne Marie Moses (1:46.70) in the 200 yard freestyle relay.

Anne Marie Moses captured wins in the 200 yard freestyle (2:08.97) and the 100 yard freestyle (58.21) while Prenzlin won the 200 yard IM (2:18.09) and 100 yard backstroke (1:05.52). Fitzgerald took first in the 50 yard freestyle (26.79) and Level won the 100 yard breaststroke.

The boys captured relay team wins in 200 yard medley relay with a time of 1:45.87 set by Dylan Weisenauer, Tate Williams, William Taylor and Andrew Evans, in the 400 yard freestyle relay with a time of 3:33.04 set by Andrew Evans, Jared Fox, Mitchell Mullholland and Weisenauer and in the 200 yard freestyle relay with a time of 1:37.24 set by Williams, Fox, Mullholland and Taylor. Weisenauer took individual wins in the 200 yard freestyle (1:53.37) and the 100 yard backstroke (57.31) while Williams captured wins in the 100 yard fly (1:00.37) and the 100 yard breaststroke (1:07.24). Taylor won the 200 yard IM (2:13.70), Evans took first in the 50 yard freestyle (23.26) and Manuel Gutierrez won the one meter diving event with a final score of 204.85.

The Little Giants return four state qualifiers this season in senior Kaity Kelly and sophomores Olivia DeRodes, MaKennah Fitzgerald and AnneMarie Moses. Kelly is team captain and the only senior.

Sophomore Rilee Overmyer qualified to districts. Juniors Hannah Kelly and Torie Miller and sophomore Sophia Biggins earned letters last season.

Alexis Prenzlin, Shelby Level and Ellie Stover are among a large group of freshmen.

"This team is very young, but it has lots of young athletes with years of big-meet experience as USA Sand Otter swimmers," Ross girls coach Tina Moses said. "We also have plenty of newcomers who are working hard and should make an impact as the season rolls along.

"I am very excited to see where this season takes the girls."

Juniors Tate Williams and Andrew Evans are back as state qualifiers for the Little Giants' boys. Seniors Jared Fox and Manuel Gutierrez, juniors William Taylor, Mitchell Mullholland and Matthew Kuyken, and freshmen Dylan Weisenauer, Zach McNutt and Cody Farrier are also among those who will compete for the boys.
