Britta Barron (No. 2 singles) and Emily Clarke (No. 3) each finished third in their flight as Fremont Ross finished its Michaels Memorial Invitational in third place as a team with 55 points.

Perrysburg won the event at 140 and Southview was second with 81 points.

"I was pretty pleased," Ross coach Rick LaFountain said. "I thought there were a couple matches we could have won for a few more points but we probably still would have finished third. Perrysburg and Southview were clearly the best teams there with four other teams (including Ross) that were very closely matched.
