Lancaster boys clear Buckeye pick

The picture is clear in the boys race but it is cloudy for the girls in the first Buckeye Central Conference Track and Field Meet Saturday at Lancaster.

"Lancaster, definitely," John Elder, Ross coach, said about the favorite's roll in the first BCC meet.

"Lancaster is strong, very strong," the Ross coach continued. "They have a 13-foot pole vaulter, a 52-foot shot putter, a

high jumper who goes 6-6 and they have good sprint and distance men.

"Lancaster is," Elder repeated, "strong and they are good."

In the chase for the first girls title, Elder's attitude changes.

"I think we can win it," he said. "I have not heard much about the other teams, except Findlay, but I think our sprinters and hurdles will get a lot of points for us.

"Findlay will fight us in the

distance races.

"We did lose to Findlay in a dual meet, but it was close," Elder said, "but I think in a bigger meet, we can beat them."

Cardell Beachum in the shot put, Jeff Draeger in the discus and Kevin Crawford in the high jump appear to be the Little Giants' top hopes for scoring points in the field events.

Maurice Jones in the sprints is expected to score Ross points.

"The boys could finish anywhere from second to fifth," Elder admitted. Shannon Carter in the hurdles, long jump and sprint relays leads the Ross girls.

Kaylene Bartson and Amy Ritzman in the middle sprints and Tami Stanley and Stacey Pasach are other possible point scorers for Ross in the mid-distance races.

The field events and preliminary running events begin at 10 a.m. and the running event finals are at 12:15 p.m. with the exception of the 4x800 relay which will be run at 10:45 a.m.

"We have to leave Fremont at 6 a.m.," Elder said, "and how we do when we get there could depend on getting down there and getting awake."

Ross girls second, boys fifth in BCC meet

LANCASTER — Findlay won the Buckeye Central Conference girls track and field title Saturday, edging Fremont Ross by two points.

Findlay had 77 points and Ross 73. Third was Newark with 47, Lancaster had 45 and Zanesville finished on the bottom with 10.

Shannon Carter of Ross was named the meet's outstanding performer.

In the boys meet, Ross finished fifth while Lancaster won the

championship.

Carter won the 100 and 300 hurdles and anchored the winning 4x200 relay.

Ross won seven girls events with other firsts going to Kelly Shaffer in the 100 and Tami Stanley in the 3200, the 4x800 relay team of Amy Ritzman, Lisa Abdoo, Kaylene Bartson and Stacy Pasch, the 4x100 relay squad of Vicki Hinojosa, Shaffer, Sandy Hammer and Trella Warfield and the 4x200 team of Hinojosa, Shaffer, Warfield and Carter.

Ross seconds included Warfield in the 100, Pasch in the 800, Jenny Zienta in the 300 hurdles, Ritzman in the long jump and the 4x400 team of Ritzman, Abdoo, Bartson and Pasch.

Emily Wise was third in the discus. Finishing fourth were Abdoo in the 1600 and Ritzman in the 800 while Samantha Augliaro was fifth in the 1600.

In the boys meet, Lancaster 99, Zanesville 52, Findlay 41½, Newark 33½ and Ross 27. Cardell Beachum's second in

the shot put was the top and Jason Hull, runner-up in the discus, were the top Ross boys finishes.

Thirds went to Jeff Draeger in the discus, Kevin Crawford in the high jump, Maurice Jones in the 100 and the 4x100 relay team of Beachum, Terry Carter, John Liggins and Jones.

Tracy Hufford in the high jump, Terry Carter in the 100 and Crawford in the 200 had fourth-place finishes. Crawford added a fifth in the 400.
