FOUL TOSSES BEAT GIANTS AT SANDUSKY

Only 13 Out Of 30
Tries Completed

All Ross high's little Giants needed last night at Sandusky was a spark, but it wasn't forthcoming and as a result the 1949-50 cage season has come to an end.

The Fremont team fell before Willard, 42-37, in a game which could easily have been taken by the locals, but wasn't.

Usually a good foul-shooting team, the Little Giants tightened up so much before the district A tournament crowd in Sandusky Junior high gym that only 13 out of 30 attempts were made good.

In the other first night game Sandusky thumped Norwalk, 62 to 47.

Willard Scores First

Willard started the scoring, Funk, a forward, hitting a free throw before Dick Sherman put the locals in the front with a fielder. Willard made it 5-2, then John Allen pegged two buckets to get the Little Giants back in the game. The quarter ended 9-8 with the Railroaders in front.

Willard moved out in front in the second quarter, getting 13 counters against eight to close the half with the score 22 to 16. At one time in the period the score was 16-all, but the locals went scoreless the remainder of the quarter, while Coach John Ihnat's boys hit for six.

In the third canto the Little Giants cut the margin by two points, starting into the last quarter with the score 29-25 against them.

Ross was outscored by one point in the final session, 13 against 12, missing seven out of 13 free tries in this period.

The game marked defeat No. 17 for Ross this season against three victories.

John Allen was again high man in the scoring column with 16 gleaned on seven field goals and two charity tosses. He outscored Jim Nowakowski, Willard's six foot eight inch center, by a single point.
