ROSS RUNNER IS FIRST IN MEET

Henry Sewell, star Fremont Ross high runner, jogged to victory over a large field in the northwestern Ohio district cross-country meet Saturday morning at Toledo as the Little Giants finished third in the team standings.

Sewell, one of Coach Whitey Althoff's most promising harriers in several seasons, crossed the finish line in 10:55.1, edging out several strong favorites from Toledo schools.

Libbey won the event, held on a two-mile course at Ottawa park, while Woodward was second.

Burdette Klawitter was next Fremont runner to place behind Sewell, finishing 15th. Clarence Chestnutwood was 22nd, Jack Arnold, 23rd, and Gale Berger, 24th. Two other Little Giant thinlies, Carl Hufford and Jim Filson, finished further back in the field of more than 50 from schools throughout the district.
