ROSS RUNNER IS FIRST IN MEET

Henry Sewell, star Fremont Ross high runner, jogged to victory over a large field in the northwest-ern Ohio district cross-country meet Saturday morning at Toledo as the Little Giants finished third in the team standings.

Sewell, one of Coach Whitey Al-thoff's most promising harriers in several seasons, crossed the finish line in 10:55.1, edging out several strong favorites from Toledo schools.

Libbey won the event, held on a two-mile course at Ottawa park, while Woodward was second.

Burdette Klawitter was next Fremont runner to place behind Sewell, finishing 15th. Clarence Chestnutwood was 22nd, Jack Arn-old, 23rd, and Gale Berger, 24th. Two other Little Giant thinlies, Carl Hufford and Jim Filson, finished further back in the field of more than 50 from schools throughout the district.
