Klingman set new personal marks in winning the 200 freestyle (2:04.38) and taking second in the 500 free (5:30.38) as she was one of 10 Little Giants to qualify to the Division I district meet Saturday at Cleveland State University.

"I'm pretty happy with that turnout," said Klingman, sporting a big smile. "I'm excited. I think all around, my year has gone well. I'm looking forward to next weekend."

Ross topped Findlay 574-527 for the sectional team crown in the girls meet. The boys were second to the Trojans, 654-451 in

the boys meet.

Sophomore Meghan Moses set new sectional records in winning both the 50 free (24.75) and 100 free (53.78). She earned the top seeds in each event for the district meet. She, Haley Fisher, Morgan Waggoner and Megan Hawk broke the pool record with a time of 1:39.74 to
