SANDUSKY — A Fremont Ross singles player and a doubles team qualified for Bowling Green State University Division I district tournament after sectional tournament play Friday at Sandusky High School.

At Norwalk, Clyde's top doubles team of Karla and Kristie Wilson advanced to the Division II district tournament in Bowling Green.

Cornelia Holst of Ross, the second-seeded singles player, will play number four seed Sarah Schroeder of Vermilion in today's sectional semifinals.

The Little Giants' first doubles team of Whitney Shanahan and Ann Darr, seeded second in the sectional, will play top-seeded Andrea Kang and Sharla Pentleton of Ashland in today's finals.

Holst defeated Debbie Berger of Mansfield Madison 6-0, 6-0 in the first round and knocked off Kristin Huguenin of Gallion 6-0, 6-2 in the second round to qualify for the semifinals.

Shanahan and Darr defeated Erin Henry and Tina Loreng of Gallion 6-0, 6-0 in their first match. The Ross duo defeated the tournament's fourth-seeded team, Mindy Marble and Betsy Mitchell of Ashland, 6-3, 0-6, 6-1 to reach the finals.

In other Ross matches, second singles player Amy Young defeated Jenny Smith of Ashland 6-2, 6-0 in the first round and stopped Emily Otto of Sandusky 6-4, 6-3 in her next match. Lynn Baker of Gallion, seeded third, defeated Young 6-0, 6-1.

Ross third singles player Gwen Gaydos had a bye in the first round before defeating Beth Coohon of Ashland 7-6 (7-5), 6-4. In the quarterfinals, top-seeded Sue Beathler of Mansfield Senior topped Gaydos 6-1, 6-0.

Jenny Maire and Andi Opre, the Little Giants' second doubles team, defeated Jodi Lorengo and Emily Maurer of Vermilion 6-1, 6-0 in the first round but lost to Kang and Pentleton in the second round 6-2, 6-1.

The Wilsons, seeded first in the sectional, defeated Marcia Stohl and Krysten Wyneski of Sandusky St. Mary's Central Catholic 6-0, 6-2 in the first round. In the second round, the Wilsons posted a straight-set win — without losing a game — over Cyndi Cook and Nicole Gildenmeister of Bellevue.

At the Division II sectional in Ottawa Hills, Port Clinton failed earn a district qualifier.

Holst beat Sarah Schroeder of Vermilion 6-1, 6-0, to advance to the finals against top-seeded Sue Beathler of Mansfield Senior.

Beathler defeated Holst in straight sets, 6-1, 6-0.

Holst qualified for the district tournament, which begins Friday at Bowling Green State University.

"She did real well ... Beathler is just tough," Ross coach Sue Badertscher said. "She's (Beathler) got muscle behind those hits, and she seems to pick up everything that's hit to her.

"Cornelia had a lot of trouble with the wind. She has a real high toss on her serve, and that's what saved her on some of her tough matches."

Shanahan and Darr, who also advanced to Friday's district competition, lost to No. 1-seeded Andrea Kang and Sharla Penleton of Ashland 6-2, 7-6 (7-2) for second place.

"It was a very rewarding weekend," Badertscher said. "It's been a long time since Ross has gone this far."
