GREG VANDYNE capped off a stellar day in style.

VanDyne anchored Ross's victorious 400-meter freestyle relay in the final event of the Little Giants' season-opening 46-44 win over Tiffin Columbian on Wednesday.

VanDyne also won the 100 breaststroke and opened the winning 200 freestyle relay.

MEGAN WASSERMAN won two individual events and was on two winning relays as the Ross girls beat Columbian 58-36.

"I'm very pleased with how the new swimmers look in the water and how the veterans performed," Ross coach **PHIL MORAN** said.

Wasserman won the 200 individual medley and the 100 butterfly and was on the 200 medley and 400 freestyle relays.

EMILY GRAYSON, JAYMELEE GLASPY and **HEATHER WILLIAMS** joined Wasserman on both relays.

Glaspy also won the 100 backstroke, and Grayson won the 100 breaststroke.

EMILY ZAMORA, CALEY MILLER, CHELSEA EARHART and **STEPHANIE MULLINS** won the 200 free relay.

JAKE ICKES, CHRIS BEIER and **ALAN GAMBLE** joined VanDyne on the meet-clinching 400 free relay. Beier, Gamble and **MATT BACHELDER** teamed with VanDyne on the 200 free relay.

Ikkes and Beier added victories in the 200 individual medley and the 50 free, respectively.



Better of the two Jakes

Leaned-down Ickes making waves for Ross

The thought of running cross country was a joke to Jake Ickes at this time last year.

The notion of competing in a triathlon caused nightmares.

But he realized something after his sophomore swimming campaign ended at Fremont Ross this past February.

"Last year was a repeat of my freshman year," Ickes said. "I knew I could have done better. So I decided I had to work a little bit harder."

During the swimming off-season, the 6-foot-3 Ickes toned his soft 203-pound frame into an athletic, muscular 203-pound mold.

And he's reaping the benefits.

On Wednesday, Ickes continued his stellar junior season, winning four events to help the Little Giants beat Findlay 65-29 at Fremont Middle School.

"It feels good to win," Ickes said. "My times right now aren't that great. But I know I am working a lot harder than I have

before. I am feeling better overall this season."

The Findlay girls, who will be one of the favorites to win the Northwest District at year's end, won all but three events and beat Ross by an identical 65-29 score.

"We have a very strong girls

team," said Findlay coach Jeff Wobser, a former University of Tennessee swimmer. "They did what they had to do."

Jaymelee Glaspy and Megan Wasserman won the 100-yard breaststroke and 200 individual medley, respectively, for the Ross girls. They also combined with Emily Grayson and Heather Williams on the winning 200 medley relay.

Ickes said he lost about 20 pounds and got down to about 180 during cross country season. He has since added muscle weight to get back up toward his original weight.

Ickes said he lost the weight with swimming in mind.

"I just want to get further," he said. "I want to go to state. To do that, I had to go into cross country to drop a couple of pounds."

Wobser certainly was impressed with the new Ickes.

"Look at where he's at today," Wobser said. "He will be that much better next year. He's a very good swimmer and will get only better."

Moran breaks team's routine

Fremont Ross's Greg VanDyne swam his best race in a tough environment on Saturday.

The senior established a personal best on his way to a victory in the 100-yard breaststroke but Napoleon handily defeated the Little Giant boys for the second straight weekend, 116-54.

"That was the nicest swim he's had in the 100 breaststroke," Ross coach Phil Moran said. "He finally took it out fast. He died at the end, but that's expected this time of year. Hopefully, he doesn't die at districts."

VanDyne said he anticipated a strong challenge from Napoleon's Jon Saul.

"I figured I'd take it out as hard as I could," he said. "I wanted to go out as hard as I could the first 50 and maintain the pace I set."

"It was the seniors last home meet at this pool. We wanted to give everything we had to make the last meet a good memory. I'm hoping to continue to drop time and hopefully make it up on the podium at districts."

VanDyne set a personal-best time in winning the 50 freestyle (23.9). Senior Rob Hoelzle took the 100 backstroke.

VanDyne, who qualified for districts in four events last year, won the 100 breaststroke and finished second in the 50 free as Napoleon won the Greater Buckeye Conference meet last Saturday.

Sophomore Megan Wasserman broke her personal record in winning the 200 freestyle in 2:07.08 on Saturday, but the Napoleon girls also registered a second convincing win, 121-49.

Wasserman normally competes in the 200 individual medley and 100 butterfly.

"Coach thought I needed a break," she said. "I got some distance in."

Wasserman was unaccustomed to the 500 freestyle, as evidenced by the ice-substitute frozen peas strapped to each shoulder after the race.

"Wasserman is a pretty dominant swimmer," Napoleon coach Larry Vocke said. "She'll be very good at districts. VanDyne is coming into his own."

Moran said that Saturday offered an opportunity to alter his lineup with Napoleon's status as a powerhouse. The Napoleon girls have won districts eight times in the last 25 years.

"Some girls had been stuck in the same events all year," Moran said. "You have to change it up. It gives the kids more confidence in their ability. Today was kind of a confidence builder."
