## Sandusky Dominates District Cross-Country

The Sandusky Blue Streaks showed their heels to the rest of the field and romped to an easy victory in the Sandusky district cross country meet. The win means that coach Wes Hartswok's team will compete in the state meet in Columbus Saturday.

Phil Amerine was the individual leader with a time of 10:30 for the two mile course. He was followed to the wire by Bob Brown, Sandusky; Frank Ferguson, Fostoria; Jim Collins, Sandusky; Dave Olsen Sandusky; Bob Carter, Clyde, and Phil Graue, Bowling Green. All these individuals qualified for the state meet.

Sandusky outdistanced second place Bowling Green by 34 points. The Blue Streaks had 22, Bowling Green had 56, Clyde 72, Fostoria 83 and Fremont Ross 145.
