Ross wins Golden Bear Invitational; St. Joe is second

Giants' Aseltine; Streaks' Golamb both shoot 73

With four golfers breaking 80, the Ross High Little Giants won the Golden Bear Invitational at Sycamore Hills Golf Course.

St. Joseph Central Catholic was second and Gibsonburg third in the ten team event.

Andrew Aseltine fired a 73 to lead the Little Giants to victory. Others who broke 80 for the Giants were Austin Young, 75, and Spencer Schabel and Kevin Vasser, who both fired 76.

The Giants fired an even 300 as a team and won the season-opening event by 18 strokes over the Crimson Streaks.

St. Joe was paced by Vince Golamb, who matched Aseltine's invitational low score of 73. Brad VanDorn shot a 79 for the Streaks.

Host Gibsonburg finished 17 strokes back of St. Joe. Derek Eddings shot 81 to pace the Golden Bears.

Other area teams in the competition were Lakota, which finished eighth; Old Fort, ninth; and Bettsville, 10th.
