Coach Harold Schahet's harriers were rained out of a meet on the District track at Bowling Green Thursday. They were supposed to compete against Toledo Whitmer and Sandusky.

The Ross runners are 6-0 for the season.

Fremont Fifth In Cross Country

Fremont Ross finished fifth in a field of 12 teams competing in the Northwestern District cross country meet Saturday at Bowling Green State university.

Winning team was Marion Hard-
ing with 37 points. Second was
Troy-Ruggles 81; third, Lima Sen-
ior, 84. First three teams advance
to the state meet at Columbus
Saturday.

Fourth in the meet was Mans-
field 116. Others: Fremont 147, To-
ledo Whitmer 183, Defiance 210,
Sandusky 236, Ashland 241, Clyde
247, Lima Shawnee 251, Attica 292.

John Schengali of Mansfield was
the individual top runner out of
84 contestants with a winning time
of 10 minutes, 27.5 seconds.

Duane Hack of Fremont finished
fifth. Gene Albert of Fremont was
19th. Hack won a gold medal; Al-
bert a silver medal.

Winner and runnerup team re-
ceived trophies. First 10 boys won
gold medals; second ten silver
medals.

Since the first 10 boys, regard-
less of team standing, may com-
pete in the state meet, Hack might
represent Ross high there this
week. However, Coach Harold
Schahet said Monday morning that
that hadn't been determined as
yet.
