Jones, Lutes jump to next meet

FOSTORIA — Fremont Ross junior Reggie Jones long jumped 22 feet, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches Wednesday to win a Division I district championship at Fostoria Memorial Stadium.

Jones and Allen Lutes, who placed fourth with a 21 9 $\frac{1}{4}$, qualified for the regional.

The top four finishers in each event qualify for the regional tournament next Thursday and Saturday at Amherst.

Brian Hill placed fifth in the shot put with a 47-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ toss, two inches shorter than the fourth and final qualifying throw.

The Little Giants boys 4x800 relay team placed eighth in 9:08.39.

The Little Giants also saw numerous athletes qualify for the finals on Friday.

Xavier Darden had the fastest advancing time in the boys 400, a 50.82. Darden (22.8) and Kelly Lytle (22.86) had the top two times in the 200. Matt Kotch also reached the finals in the 800 with a 2:06.63.

The boys 4x100 team of Lytle, Darden, Jordan Mackey and Robert Atkins qualified with a 43.86, and the boys 4x400 relay of Lytle, David Rhodes, Jordan Mackey and Xavier Darden advanced with a 3:37.28.

Lindsay Frontz (2:28.01) and Molly Gocke (2:32.05) advanced in the girls 800, Fallon Bailey (27.8) and Taneshia McKinstry (27.85) moved on in the girls 200 and Tiffany Sweeney (63.7) and Delana Sims (65.0) advanced in the girls 400.

The girls 4x100 relay team of Christy Linder, McKinstry, Robertson and Bailey advanced in 51.63.

Lytle advanced to the semifinals with a season-best 10.84 in the 100. Atkins also advanced with an 11.28. Lutes (15.73) and Greg Burroughs (16.25) reached the semifinals in the 110 hurdles.

Bailey (12.6) and Adrienne Robertson (13.24) reached the semis in the girls 100.

Ross second at district

Sophomore Lytle moves on in three events

FOSTORIA — Kelly Lytle won the 100 and took second in the 200 as the Fremont Ross boys took second at the Division I district track and field tournament

at Fostoria Memorial Stadium.

Lytle ran a 22.41 to win the 200. He was second in the 100 with an 11.02 and joined Xavier Darden, Jordan Mackey and Robert Atkins on the 4x100 relay team, which also placed second in 43.86.

"His 200 time, he just got out," said Ross coach Jeff Opelt. "He was starting to run the first half real hard, and it showed. He was running real relaxed."

The Little Giants were second with 74 points, behind Opelt's old team, Sandusky, which had 90. The top four placers advance to the regional competition next Thursday in Amherst.

Darden took second in the 400 with a 50.38. Steve Dagg won the high jump with a 6-5. Teammate Reggie Jones was third.

Lutes was seventh in the 110 hurdles in 15.74. The Ross 4x400 team of Mackey, Mike Ziemke, Dave Rhodes and Matt Kotch was eighth in 3:44.21, and the 4x800 team was also eighth in 9:08.57.

In Wednesday's action, Jones and Allen Lutes qualified in the long jump with a 22-3 $\frac{1}{4}$ and a 21-9 $\frac{1}{4}$, respectively.

The Little Giants' girls were seventh with 54 points. Findlay won with 81.


Lindsay Fronz won the 800 in 2:22.04 to lead the Little Giants.

"Lindsay in the 800 was just fantastic," said Opelt. "She got right out there and led the whole way. It's tough to run an 800 by yourself and make everyone else catch up."

The Ross 4x200 team of Christy Linder, Tanesha McKinstry, Adrienne Robertson and Fallon Bailey took second in 1:46.76. Birna Hannesdottir took second in the shot put with a 36-2 $\frac{1}{4}$. Fallon Bailey was third in the 200 in 26.87 and third in the 100 in 12.58 and the 4x100 team of Christy Linder, McKinstry, Robertson and Bailey was fourth in 51.65.

Also for the Little Giants, Tiffany Sweeney was fifth in the 400 in 63.92. Delana Simms was seventh in the 400 in 64.85. McKinstry was eighth in the 200 in 28.64 and Robertson was eighth in the 100 in 13.49.

"I thought the girls did pretty well. I was pleased with their results," Opelt said.
