## Ross Deadlocks Sandusky Golf Team In Opener

Fremont Ross golfers had the better balance in scoring Thursday to gain a tie with Sandusky in the golf season opener at Fremont Country Club. The Little Giants earned a point for low team total to deadlock the match score  $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $5\frac{1}{2}$ .

Match play concluded with Ross winning two and losing three and trailing  $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $4\frac{1}{2}$ . The home team had the better team total with 223 strokes to 228 for Sandusky to gain the tying point. There is a possibility of two points in each individual match and one point for team medal.

Tom Ohlemacher, Sandusky number one man, took medalist honors with a three-over par 39 as he took two points from Jeff Gibbs. In individual matches points are awarded one for match play and one for medal play.

Bob Van Hook, number three man, was low for Ross with 42 strokes to win two points from Sam Thiede. Number two Ross golfer Craig Wright shot a 43 to garner two points from Pete Manguerra.

The final half-point in individual matches was taken by Ross' number five man John Waggoner. Waggoner shot a 46 to tie Roger Newton for medal but had a bad final hole to drop the point for match play.


