MANSFIELD—A senior and a freshman won two events each and two other freshmen won as the Fremont Ross boys swim team defeated the Mansfield Tygers 100-80 Saturday.

In the girls meet, Mansfield won 10-9-73.

Senior Ryan Wing captured the 200 and 500 freestyles for the Aqua Giants boys. Hans Schmidlin, a freshman, took the 50 and 100 freestyle sprints while classmates Erik Luse and Andrew Humberger won the butterfly and breaststroke, respectively.

Wing, Schmidlin and Luse also swam on the winning 200 and 400 free relays.

"I am happy with the way we are swimming," Ross coach Denise Kovaleski said. "Both teams are pulling some surprises while swimming up to my expectations."

The Aqua Giants were 1-2 in the 100 free with Lee Huffman following Schmidlin.

Ross splits with PC; OH wins double dual

PORT CLINTON—Leslie Hasselbach set Fremont Ross girls diving record as the Aqua Giants split a boys and girls swimming and diving meet with Port Clinton Tuesday.

The Ross girls, 2-1-1, defeated Port Clinton 123-53 while the Port Clinton boys handed the Aqua Giants their first loss in three meets, 107-78.

In a double dual meet at Oak Harbor, the Rockets boys and girls turned in two wins apiece. The Rocket boys defeated Calvert 75-25 and Toledo Central Catholic 75-15. The Oak Harbor girls topped Calvert 81-9 and beat TCC 71-21.

Hasselbach, a senior, scored 257.20 points for her six dives, well above her own mark of 242.50 set last season.

"All of our divers, boys and girls, had career highs," Ross coach Denise Kovaleski said.

Jennifer Newsman was second in diving for the Ross girls with 231.40 points. In the boys diving, Brian Thatcher was third with 205.20 points and Shawn Tooman fourth with 135.00.

Annie Mears won the individual medley and backstroke and was also a member of the Aqua Giants' winning medley and 400 freestyle relays.

Addie Baker also won two events for the Ross girls, taking the 200 freestyle and the 500 free while also swimming legs of the medley and 400 free relays.

In the boys meet, Ryan Wing won the 200 and 5000 freestyles and also swam on the Aqua Giants' relay winning medley relay.

Hans Schmidlin won the 50 and 100 mfreestyle sprints and also swam a leg of the medley relay.

Fremont Ross posted a pair of wins over Huron and Oak Harbor defeated Sandusky twice in high school swimming Saturday.

The Ross girls raised their record to 3-1-1 with a 99-70 victory over the Tigers in the Margaretta High School pool. The Ross boys, 3-1, prevailed 96-72.

The Ross girls won eight events with Annie Mears, Addie Baker and Mindy Ickes winning two events apiece.

Mears was first in the 50 freestyle and backstroke; Baker took the 200 and 500 freestyles; and Ickes won the individual medley and breaststroke. All three swam on the winning medley and 200 freestyle relays.

Ross is off until next Saturday, when it hosts Fostoria at Fremont Junior High School.

"It was just a good, solid effort," he said after the Rockets boys team topped Sandusky 115-68 and the girls paddled past the Blue Streaks 126-57. Both Rockets teams are 4-0.

The Oak Harbor boys won eight of 12 events including a pair of wins by Ben Wood. In addition to swimming on the Rockets' winning 200 and 400 freestyle relays, Wood also won

the 100 and 200 freestyles.

The Rockets recorded 1-2 finishes in diving and the 100 free. Casey Wright was first in diving with teammate Jeff Barker second. Touching after Wood in the 100 was Brian Pointer.

The Oak Harbor girls won all 12 events, sweeping the top two spots in the six of them.

Ross junior Jennifer Newman, meanwhile, placed eighth with 334.55 points.


The Aqua Giants also sent eight swimmers to the event at Cleveland State, which featured individuals from 46 schools from across Ohio.

Aqua Giants win meets at home

Swimmers from Fostoria were third into the pool as Fremont Ross won a pair of high school swim meets Saturday.

Swimming in the humid, dark, dank confines of the Fremont Junior High School pool, the Ross boys and girls teams chalked up their fourth victories. The girls won 50-34 to improve to 4-1-1 while the boys posted a 54-32 victory and are now 4-1.

"I think the kids were swimming more against each other than against the other team," Ross coach Denise Kovaleski said. "They pushed each other more than Fostoria pushed them."

The wins, according to Kovaleski, were marked by Ross swimmers chipping several sec-

onds off their personal best times in what was basically a junior varsity meet for the Aqua Giants.

Several Ross swimmers and divers competed at the Cleveland Invitational Saturday.

"The JV kids pulled out some two to three second drops," Kovaleski said. "I think a lot of it had to do with being at home in familiar territory."

Ross generally swims one or two meets at home per season. Most of those meets are at the Sandusky County YMCA with an occasional splash into the junior high pool, which serves as the Ross practice facility.

Karen Wonderly and Kristen Humberger were double winners for the Ross girls. Wonderly won the 200 and 500 freestyles, while Humberger was first in the indi-

vidual medley and backstroke. Humberger also swam a leg of the Aqua Giants' winning medley and 400 free relays. Wonderly also swam on the winning 200 and 400 free relays.

The girls had a 1-2 finish in the 500 free, with Tricia Tooman finishing behind Wonderly.

In the boys meet, Ross got a pair of first-place finishes from Jerry Dahms in the individual medley and 100 freestyle. Dahms was also on the Aqua Giants' winning medley and 200 freestyle relays.

The boys posted 1-2 finishes in two events: the breaststroke with Andrew Humberger and M.J. Dumminger and the 100 freestyle with Humberger and runner-up to Dahms.

The next meet for Ross is Wednesday at Sandusky Perkins.

OAK HARBOR — Fremont Ross set three total records but dropped both ends of a boys and girls swimming and diving meet Tuesday.


Oak Harbor, 10-2, won all of the relays.

Wing won the 500 free in 5:16.84.


