District Wrestling This Weekend To Involve 127 Schoolboy Matmen

Fremont Junior High Gym Site Of Tournament

Total of 127 boys representing 12 schools and competing in 11 different weights will be in action Friday in first and second round sessions of the District wrestling tournament in the Girls' gym, Fremont Junior high school.

First round will be conducted Friday afternoon beginning at 3:30. Second round goes on Friday night, beginning at 7:30.

Semifinals will be on Saturday afternoon, beginning at 3 with the finals Saturday night, beginning at 7:30.

It is a single elimination tournament with the finalist (the winner) in each weight division qualifying for the state finals at Columbus, Fremont is one of four District sites in Northwest Ohio.

Schools competing are host Fremont Ross, Fremont St. Joseph, Clyde, Ashland, Arcadia, Castalia Margaretta, Huron, Mansfield Senior, Mansfield Madison, Sandusky, Vermillion and Fostoria.

Huron Favored

Huron won the District at Fremont last year and is rated the pre-choice this year. Of 11 top-seeded boys in each weight division, Huron has three and of 11 second-seeded boys in each division, Huron has four. That makes the total of seven top or second-seeded boys for Huron. Next in line are Sandusky and Fremont St. Joseph with three first or second seeds, then Fostoria, Mansfield Madison and Mansfield Senior with two each, and Fremont Ross, Clyde and Ashland with one seeded boy. Castalia Margaretta, Vermillion and Arcadia have no first or second-seeded boys.

Seeding is based on best won-loss records in dual meets.

Jim Perry Ends His Holdout

CLEVELAND (AP)—Jim Perry, lanky ace of the Cleveland Indians' pitching staff last year, has ended his holdout. He will head for the Tribe's Tucson training camp soon.

Reportedly, he won a 70 per cent pay boost to \$20,000 this year.

With Perry in the fold, only three Indians are unsigned — pitchers Dick Stigman, Wynn Hawkins and Barry Latman.

Hoot Evers, who has handled such details since Frank Lane left his job as general manager here, remarked that Perry was a shrewd bargainer, that he "has a good idea of what he's worth and sticks to that figure."

The 24-year-old righthander tied Chuck Estrada of Baltimore for most games won in the American League last year, winning 18 and losing 10.

Last year was Perry's second season, and he set one record of which he is not proud—35 gopher balls, a club record for home run

Kent Staters Surprise BGSU

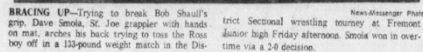
