

# Ross girls in district

ASHLAND — Fremont Ross won a girls Division I sectional tournament title Tuesday with its 15th straight victory.

The Little Giants, 16-3, rode the two-hit pitching of Jessica Rollins to a 10-0 triumph over Shelby at Brookside Park.

"Jessica was powerful today," Ross coach Cheryl Coressel said. "It is the best I have seen her pitch."

The Little Giants will play Mansfield Madison, 13-5, at 4:30

p.m. May 18 in the district tournament at Ashland.

"It was a clean game all around," Coressel said. "It was the best defensive game we have played."

The Little Giants did not commit an error, while Rollins recorded seven strikeouts and walked only one. Rollins also drove in two runs.

Ross hitters led off the first three innings with triples. Dawn Zerman, who finished the day with three hits in four at bats,

tripled leading off the game and scored on Belinda Sandoval's base hit.

Natalie Robbins led off the second with a three-bagger as Ross scored four times, taking advantage of three errors.

Tricia Busdeker tripled in the third as Ross stretched its lead to 6-0.

Ross scored three runs in the fourth on four hits and a fielder's choice.

Sandoval and Busdeker each had two hits as Shelby fell to 9-10.
