Grossman and Swaisgood qualify for district play

BOWLING GREEN — Dan Swaisgood and Dan Grossman of Fremont Ross had to work overtime to do it, but the pair of Little Giants qualified for district golf competition Friday.

Swaisgood and Grossman were involved in a three-man playoff with Andy Smith of Defiance for the second and third individual qualifying spots behind Defiance's Jeff Hunt.

Grossman, Swaisgood and Smith each shot a 7-over par 79 in the Division I Sectional Tournament on the 6,117-yard Bowling Green State University Course.

The playoff began on the 10th hole, a par-5. Swaisgood made par, while Grossman and Smith made bogey.

Five holes later, Grossman made par on the short par-3 15th hole, while Smith made bogey.

Bowling Green won the team championship with 307 strokes. Findlay with 319 and Perrysburg

with 321 also advance to the district next Friday at Hillcrest Golf Course in Findlay.

Defiance finished fourth at 322, and Ross lost a fifth-man tiebreaker with Oregon Clay for fifth place after both teams finished at 327.

Maumee placed seventh with 344; Tiffin Columbian, which won a fifth-man tiebreaker with Springfield after each team shot 350, finished eighth; Anthony Wayne was 10th with 353 followed by Fostoria with 354 and Sandusky with 393.

Rob Randall, Dave Zinkand and Dave Brown shot 83, 86 and 93, respectively, for Ross.

Mike Windisch of BG earned medalist honors with a 75, going out in 39 and shooting even-par 36 on the inward half.

The Bobcats also got a 76 from Tait Metz, a 77 from Scott Jones and a 79 from Jon Cavanagh.
