Mapus and Archer topped Perkins' Srik Reddy and Steve Tomasula 5-7, 6-4, 6-4 in the semis.

Dierking lost to Port Clinton's Erick Gale, the No. 1 seed, 6-3, 6-4 in the championship singles match.

Dierking, 12-1, beat Port Clinton's Walker Roth 6-0, 6-1 in the quarters and Norwalk's Brian Canterbury 6-7 (7-5), 6-2, 7-5 in the semis.

"That was probably some of the best tennis he's played all year," St. Joe coach Brian Miller said of Dierking. "In the semis he had a problem with his serve. He was missing his second serves but he came around after the break and hit a lot of first serves against Gale."

The victory was the 50th career victory for Gale, 24-1. The sophomore also won last year's

sectional title.
