Ross runs roughshod through BCC tourney

NEWARK — Fremont Ross made a shambles of the first Buckeye Central Conference Wrestling tournament, winning all three matches while claiming the championship Saturday at Newark High School.

Ross 145-pounder Jon Ramirez was named the most valuable wrestler and Little Giants Coach Al Voggenthaler won coach of the year honors. Six Ross wrestlers, including Ramirez, won individual titles and four others were runners-up.

The Little Giants' toughest competition was from Findlay but the Little Giants won seven

of the 13 matches in a 33-25 victory. It was no contest in the other two matches as Ross demolished Newark 66-3 and Lancaster 55-8, giving the Little Giants a 3-0 record. Findlay was second at 2-1.

Ross wrestled Newark first, Lancaster second and finally, Findlay. The order of the matches was settled by a draw.

"It went like it figured out on paper," Voggenthaler said. "We wrestled Findlay last, like it should have been."

Ross had beaten Findlay by 14 points earlier this season and from what Voggenthaler knew about Lancaster and Zanesville,

the Little Giants figured to win the tourney comfortably. Only Findlay did not yield that easily.

"They caught us three different times in matches I figured we could win," Voggenthaler said.

The team title was based on dual meet and the top two individual finishes was determined by records in the particular weight division.

Jon Ramirez was 3-0, pinning all of this opponents. He quickest fall was in three minutes and three seconds against Robert Anderson of Newark.

Other individual champs for Ross included Greg Abdo, 125,

Jamie Ramirez, 130, Matt Marinis, 135, Troy Williamson, 152, and Dave Carroll, 189. All had 3-0 records.

Runners-up for Ross with 2-1 marks were Jason Koebel, 103, Daniel Costilla, 112, Mike Rocha, 119, and Jeff Tomlinson, 160.

Other highlights for Ross included Greg Abdo with two pins and a technical fall; Jamie Ramirez had two technical falls (a win by 15 of more points) and a fall and Marinis recorded two pins and a superior decision. Marinis had the quickest fall, pinning Andrew Kiger of Lancaster in 40 seconds.
