Ross Places Third In District Swim; 10 Locals To State

State university Friday night. Other teams and how they placed: Lima Senior 80, Fremont Ross 55½, Mansfield 21, Findlay 15, Perkins 2.

Jack Talbot, Ross high's sensational 100-yard backstroker, set a new district record in that event with a time of one minute, 2.2 seconds to break the old record of 1:03.7 set by Price and Talbot of Ross. Talbot's career backstroke mark is 1:02 flat.

Talbot is one of the 10 Fremont boys who move on to the state swimming meet March 4 at Columbus. First four places in each event in the district qualified a boy for the state.

Bob Vogel goes as a third place finisher and Paul Thatcher as fourth place finisher in the 50-free style; John Myers for a second in the 200-free; Talbot for a first in the 100-backstroke; Lynn Huffman for a third in the 100-breaststroke; Bill Wensinger for a second in the 100-free; Dave Serwin for a third and Jim Kaufman for a fourth in the diving division; and both the Ross 200-medley relay team (composed of Huffman, Talbot, Don Slesman and Vogel) and the Ross 200-freestyle relay team (composed of Thatcher, Bob Cliburn, Wensinger and Myers; advance, the medley foursome coming in third and the freestyle quartet placing second.

Ross was district champion last year.

Several other district records fell yesterday. Mike Carpenter of Lima won the 100-breaststroke in 1:12.8 to beat the old record of 1:16.7 set by Francis Sherman of Ross. Martin Schenk of Lima won the 100-individual medley in 2:30, a new district record in the first year of the event. The 200-medley relay team of Lima (Chuck Hunter, Bob Hunter, Carpenter, Jim Taylor) set a new record of 1:50.3 topping the old mark of 1:57.6 set by Fremont Ross in 1958.

Other first place winners included Mike Bennett, Sandusky, 50-free in 24.2 seconds; Bob Hunter, Lima, 100-butterfly in 1:00.7; Ralph Rhoades, Lima, 200-free in 2:18.2; Dave Wilt, Lima, 100-free in 56.9 seconds; Dean Scheid, Sandusky, diving; Sandusky (Tom Kessler, Tim Ziemke, Dave Scott, Bennett) in the 200-freestyle relay, time 1:39 flat.
