Fremont, Clyde Wrestlers Vie In Tournament

Sandusky Countians
Compete At Whitmer
In District Friday

Fremont Ross high's alignment of wrestlers to compete in the District tournament Friday and Saturday at Toledo Whitmer (not Findlay as reported earlier) was announced this week by Head Coach Mal Mackey.

There'll be four award winners in each weight division at Whitmer and the top three will move on to the State wrestling tournament to be held at Lakewood on February 21 and 22.

Weigh-in at the District tourney will be held at 9 a.m. Friday. First match is carded for 1 p.m.

Competing schools in the District are Fremont Ross, Mansfield, Bowling Green, Toledo Whitmer, Clyde, Toledo Clay, Rogers, Sylvania, Sandusky, Toledo Central Catholic, Fostoria, Toledo De-Vilbiss and Huron.

Ross high's wrestling team entered the final round of the District tournament at Toledo Whitmer this afternoon tied for third place with Fostoria, both with 10 points.

Host Whitmer led at the half-way mark with 19 points and Toledo Central Catholic was second with 13 points.

Finals are scheduled to begin at 7:30 tonight.

Four top wrestlers in each division will be given District awards and the best three will move on to the state wrestling meet in Lakewood next Friday and Saturday.

Five Ross High Wrestlers Win Trip To State

Five Fremont Ross wrestlers will participate in the State Wrestling tournament Friday and Saturday at Lakewood.

Qualifiers for the state are Dick Swedersky, Jim Otermin, Neil Schneider, Russ Nitschke and Virgil Sheets of Coach Mal Mackey's grappling squad.

Swedersky was heavyweight champion, Otermin 168-pound champ and Schneider 141-pound champ at Toledo Whitmer in the District event Friday and Saturday. Nitschke placed second in the 130-pound division and Sheets third in the 148-pound weight.

First three places in each event qualified for the state.

Whitmer won the team title with Clyde second and Ross fifth. Clyde also will have representatives in the state meet.
