Jahns Qualifies In Dash Event

Bob Jahns of Fremont Ross Friday qualified in the 22-yard dash to enter this afternoon's District Class AA finals of track and field at Bowling Green State university.

Ross, Clyde and Oak Harbor are entered in the AA finals which start at 2 this afternoon. Lima Senior is leading the team division with 10 points. Clyde has one point.

In Class A, Elmore is ahead with 10 points on the strength of Harold Semrock winning the shot put (45 feet, 5½ inches) and placing second in the broad jump.
