Hasselbach sets 3 records

OAK HARBOR — Leslie Hasselbach of Fremont Ross set a sectional, pool and school record Friday in the Northwest Ohio Sectional Diving at Oak Harbor High School.

The Ross senior scored 477.75 points in her 11 dives, runner-up Callie Bodnar of Oak Harbor had 411.35 and Jennifer Newman of Ross turned in her career best of 399.65 for third.

The top three from each of the four sectional plus 20 at-large qualifiers will dive in the district meet Thursday at Bowling Green State University.

"We hit the 'magic 20,'" Ross

diving coach Gil Root said. "That's what we had been looking for all year."

The "magic 20," Root explained, is a combined score of 20 from the

scores of three judges when you toss out the high and the low scores of the five diving judges.

"You do that, and you score in the 460s," Root said. "Today, Leslie got 477 — she had a fan-

tastic day."

Hasselbach's school record, also the Oak Harbor pool and sectional record, was 406.35 she set last year.

In the boys diving, Mike Chrapkiewicz of Port Clinton set a school record while winning with 483.85 points. The PC school record was 438.35 set by Chrapkiewicz earlier this season.

Kip Sorgen gave Port Clinton a 1-2 finish with 424.10 points.

Brian Thatcher of Ross, despite having a failed dive, finished fourth with 349.00 points.

The swimming phase of the sectional begins at 11 a.m. today also at Oak Harbor High School.

3 Ross swimmers set records

OAK HARBOR — Three Fremont Ross swimmers set sectional records and Oak Harbor won both the boys and girls meets Saturday at Oak Harbor high School.

The Rockets picked up 380 points to win the boys meet and the Rockets girls had 381 to take the girls meet. Perkins was second in both, losing by a point in the boys meet and by 4 1/2 in the girls meet.

Fremont Ross was third in the girls meet with 295 and the boys finished fifth with 231.

The top three finishers in each individual event automatically qualified for the district meet Thursday through Saturday at Bowling Green State University. Several area swimmers earned at-large berths when times were compared to the three other Northwest Ohio sectional meets.

Ryan Wing, Mindy Ickes and Annie Mears set records while winning individual titles for Ross.

Wing eclipsed the year-old mark of Oak Harbor's Ben Wood in the 500-meter freestyle, finishing in five minutes, 7.11 seconds. The old mark was 5:10.72.

Ickes recorded a 2:19.77 in lowering the girls 200-meter individual medley by nearly five seconds. The old mark of 2:24.67 was set by Betsy Verb of Oak Harbor in 1993.

Mears set a 100-meter backstroke record with a 1:03.21 effort, breaking the mark of 1:06.51 set in 1989 by a Tiffin Calvert swimmer.

It was the fourth record in two days for the Aqua Giants. Friday, diver Leslie Hasselbach set a girls mark.

Wing, who had the only first place for the Aqua Giants boys,

also qualified with a third place in the 200 free, recording a 1:54.63. He also swam a leg of the third-place 400-meter freestyle team which finished in 3:41.56. Joining Wing on the team were Lee Huffman, Erik Luse and Hans Schmidlin.

Brian Pointer won the 50 and 100 freestyle sprints to lead the Oak Harbor boys. His 22.36 seconds in the 50 wiped out the old mark of 22.58 set by Steve Tann of Perkins in 1989. Pointer won the 100 in 49.4.

The Rockets also won the 200 and 400 freestyle relays with Pointer swimming the anchor leg on both the relays. The 400 with Wood, Aaron Hemminger and Ron Lajti swimming the other legs won in 3:27.96. The 200 with Hemminger, Wood, and Andy Jenkins on the other legs, won in a meet and pool record 1:31.55. The old mark was 1:32.97 set by

The Ross girls other first place was in the 200-meter medley relay with the team of Ickes, Mears, Addie Baker and Tuesday Miller winning in 2:02.99. The same quartet also qualified for the district with a third place in the 400 free relay, finishing in 4:02.57.

The Oak Harbor 400 relay team

of Andrea Lange, Azure Weis, Monica Tabbert and Melanie Hamann won in a record 3:48.55. The old mark of 3:50.86 was set by Perkins four years ago.

The Rocket girls also set a record in the 200 free with the same squad finishing in 1:44.42, beating the mark of 1:46.65 set by Oak Harbor last year.
