Dr. Gary V. Branson

Dr. Gary V. Branson served as the school superintendent for Fremont from 1977-1981. During his tenure, he was responsible for passing a bond issue and remodeling the old Junior High School. He updated the system on student records and supervised the construction of Fremont's first all-weather track.

Dr. Branson's philosophy was "Focus on Students." A self-described sports junkie, he felt attending student events was an extremely important responsibility. He also viewed it as one of the most enjoyable parts of his job.

In all the communities he has been associated with, Gary has always believed that the community support at Fremont is second to none.

Dr. Branson received his Ph.D. in Education Administration from The Ohio State University in 1974.
