FINDLAY — Paced by medalist Randy Fife, Findlay won the Buckeye Conference golf championship Monday at Findlay Country Club. Fife fired a low 77-stroke total as Findlay's four-man team totalled 324 strokes.

This provided a 17-stroke advantage over second place Mansfield, 341.

Ross, led by the 85 of Jeff Gibbs, was fourth with 354 strokes.

Scores were not up to previous Buckeye Conference standards. On the par 72 course only three golfers broke 80. They were Fife, Elyria's Tom Dunlap, 78, and Mansfield's Gary Hager, 78.
