

Aqua Giants build around solid nucleus

Despite putting the largest squad at Fremont Ross in five years into the pool, Tom Thomson says this high school swimming season is one to build on.

"This will primarily be a building year on the girls, and we have a lot of first-year swimmers on the boys team," Thomson said. "But we have a real strong nucleus from our letter-winners."

The eight boys and six girls that have lettered previously for the Aqua Giants could result in a more promising 1991-92 season than expected.

"Things are going really well," Thomson said. "In some cases, the training is ahead of schedule for the kids when it comes to technique."

"It's going to be important how good they get in condition because a lot of our races are decided in the last 15 or 20 feet, and that's where it shows up."

Returning for the Ross boys are captains Chris Schaaf and Kent Huffman, Aaron King, Lee Huffman, diver Johnny Popoca, Geoff Streeter, Ryan Wing and David Zinkand. The Ross girls return captains Angie Sprenger and Tracy Baker as well as diver Leslie Hasselbach, Heather

Mears, Ronelle Mahr and Shannon Vaffis.

"Right now, we're using our first swimmers (letterwinners) as utility swimmers," Thomson said. "We're putting them in positions where we can attempt to gather as many points as we can."

"In our younger swimmers, we're trying to find out strengths and weaknesses."

Thomson is counting a solid group of youthful swimmers to produce for the Aqua Giants in a year or so.

"One nice thing is that I don't have to hope that they develop; they will develop," he said. "It's

a given. As coaches, we have to provide them with the growth. It's definitely a coaching year."

Thomson has been associated with Ross swimming since 1983. He was head coach in 1987-88 but took a two-year hiatus before returning last year.

Bob Lozano returns as the Ross diving coach, while Portia Thomas and Denise Dumbroff will help Thomson coach the girls.

The Aqua Giants, who opened the season against Port Clinton last Monday with a 95-90 boys' victory and a 111-61 girls' win, return to the water today against Calvert at the Tiffin YMCA.

TIFFIN — A dominating performance by the Fremont Ross girls swim team Wednesday ended in a 122-47 victory over Tiffin Calvert.

The Ross boys, meanwhile, eased to a 119-48 victory over the Senecas at the Tiffin YMCA.

The Aqua Giants took first and second place in every event in the girls' meet.

Tracie Baker led the way with four victories, including individual wins in the 200 and 500 freestyle events. Baker continued her fine freestyle swimming, anchoring Ross's winning 200 and 400 freestyle relay squads.

Ronelle Mahr and Addie Baker each had three victories. Mahr won the 100 butterfly and swam on the winning 200-medley relay and 400 free relay teams.

Addie Baker took first in the 200 individual medley and the 100 freestyle, while joining with Mahr, Angie Sprenger and Tracie Baker on the winning 400 free relay.

Chris Schaaf matched Tracie Baker's effort for the boys, winning the 200 IM and the 100 freestyle as well as helping the 200 medley relay and 200 free relay to victories.

Ryan Wing and Lee Huffman had three victories apiece.

Wing 200 and 500 freestyle swims as well as the winning 400 free relay. Huffman took first in the 100 breaststroke and swimming on the medley relay and 200 free relay.

The Fremont Ross girls swim team remained undefeated in three meets Saturday, while the Ross boys fell to 2-1.

The Aqua Giants defeated the Fostoria girls 57-30 but lost to the Fostoria boys 46-40.

Tracie Baker, Addie Baker and Ronelle Mahr each won two individual events and swam on the winning Ross girls, 200 and 400 free relays.

Mahr won the 50 freestyle and butterfly event, Tracie Baker took first in the 200 and 500 freestyle and Addie Baker captured first in the 100 freestyle and 200 individual medley.

Chris Schaaf led the Ross boys with victories in the 50 and 100 freestyle swims, while Ryan Wing won the 500 freestyle and helped the Aqua Giants' 400 free relay team to first place.

In one other meet, both Oak Harbor High School swim teams

remained undefeated after five meets.

The Oak Harbor boys won a double dual over Sandusky and Huron — 59-32 and 78-12, respectively; and the Rockets' girls team duplicated the feat — 61-31 over Sandusky and 77-13 over Huron.

Sandusky teams down Ross, Rockets

Sandusky swim teams swept Fremont Ross and Oak Harbor teams Saturday.

Sandusky's Aqua Streaks topped the Ross boys 90-80 and the girls swam past the Aqua Giant girls 98-71. Sandusky Perkins hand Oak Harbor's teams losses, handing the Rocket boys their first loss 97-89 and the Rocket girls fell 101-85.

In the Sandusky-Ross girls meet, the Baker sisters, Tracie and Addie were in on four winning events.

Tracie Baker won the 200 (2:10.01) and 500 (5:45.75) freestyles while Addie took the individual medley (2:34.88) and the backstroke (1:14.57). Both Bakers swam on the Aqua Giants' winning 200 and 400 relays. Angie

The Rockets won more events, but the Pirates were still able to pull out victories.

Oak Harbor has never beaten Perkins in swimming.

Oak Harbor's boys won eight of 12 events, while the Rockets' girls took first in six events. The Pirates' ability to finish second and third proved to be the difference in the meet.

The Rockets' boys team, 6-1,

got victories in the 200 medley relay and 200 free relay, as well as individual victories from Ben Wood in the 200 free, Joe Tack in the 200 individual medley and 100 backstroke, Mark Weber in the 50 and 100 free, and Craig Harder in the 100 butterfly.

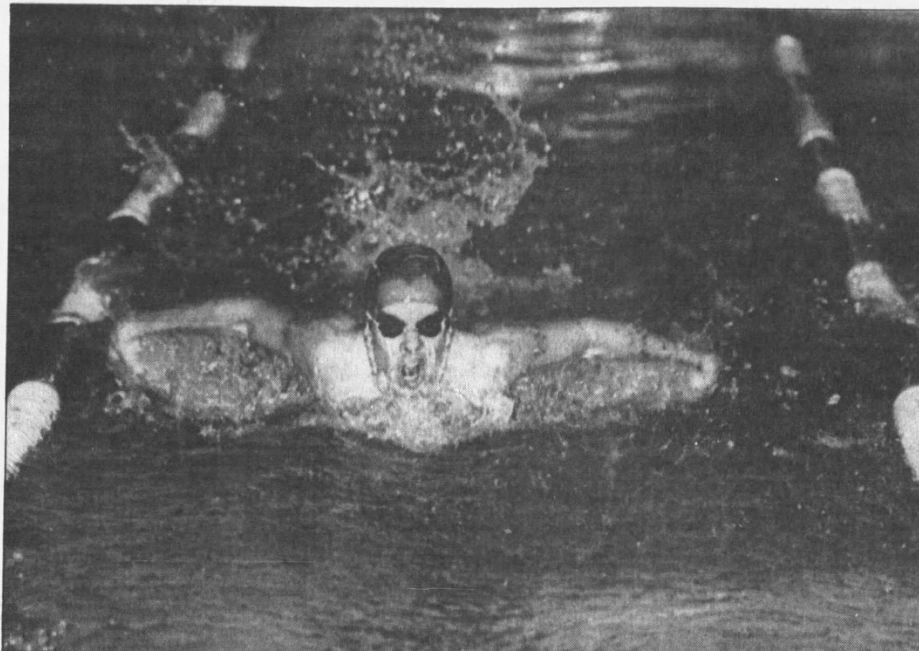

Aqua Giants split at home meet

Fremont Ross split with Fostoria Saturday in a rare home swim meet for the Aqua Giants Saturday.

The Ross girls splashed past the Redmen 64-22, but the Ross boys bowed by 10, 48-38 in the Sandusky County YMCA pool.

The meet was the second of three home meets at the YMCA this season for Ross, which otherwise swims an "all road" schedule.

The Aqua Giants won all 11 girls events, including top two sweeps in four events. Tracie Baker won her specialties, the 200 and 500 freestyles, and anchored the winning 200 and 400 freestyle relays. The 400 relay swam to a 4:13.57 clocking.

Ronelle Mahr and Addie Baker won two individual events. Mahr won the 50 freestyle and came back in the next — the 100 butterfly — to win again. Baker was first in the 200 individual medley and the 100 backstroke.

Mahr also swam on the Aqua Giants' winning medley relay and the 400 free relay. Addie Baker led off the 200 and 400 free relays.

Other individual winners for the Aqua Giants included Shannon Vaffis in the 100 freestyle and Heather Mears in the 100 breaststroke.

Chris Schaaf led the Ross boys' effort, winning the 50 and 100 freestyles. The only other

first for the Aqua Giants was by Ryan Wing in the 500 freestyle.

In one other meet, Oak Harbor swam past Port Clinton twice.

The Oak Harbor girls won every event in a 142-40 victory, which upped their record to 7-3 and dropped Port Clinton to 1-6.

Betsy Verb, Azure Weis, Melanie Hamann and Heather Kohli each won two individual events for the Rockets to go with Callie Bodnar's victory in the diving

competition.

In the boys meet, Oak Harbor defeated Port Clinton 107-76 as Ben Wood, Bob Verb and Mark Weber won two individual events apiece and the Rockets swept the relays.

Swimming

Fremont Ross swimming coach Tom Thomson believes the Aqua Giants' tough time in the Northview pool Tuesday will benefit them in the near future.

Although Ross came home with two boys and two girls dual losses, Thomson is thinking ahead to the sectional meet in two weeks.

"The biggest benefit is Northview's pool is 25 meters," Thomson said. "It's an overdistance pool and the kids work harder."

Most of the Aqua Giants' meets are held in pools that are measured in yards.

"It will benefit us two weeks from now," Thomson said. "It tends to help them swim faster when we hit sectionals."

The Ross girls lost 54-39 to Northview and 59-34 to Southview, while the boys lost 67-26 to Northview and 63-30 to Southview.

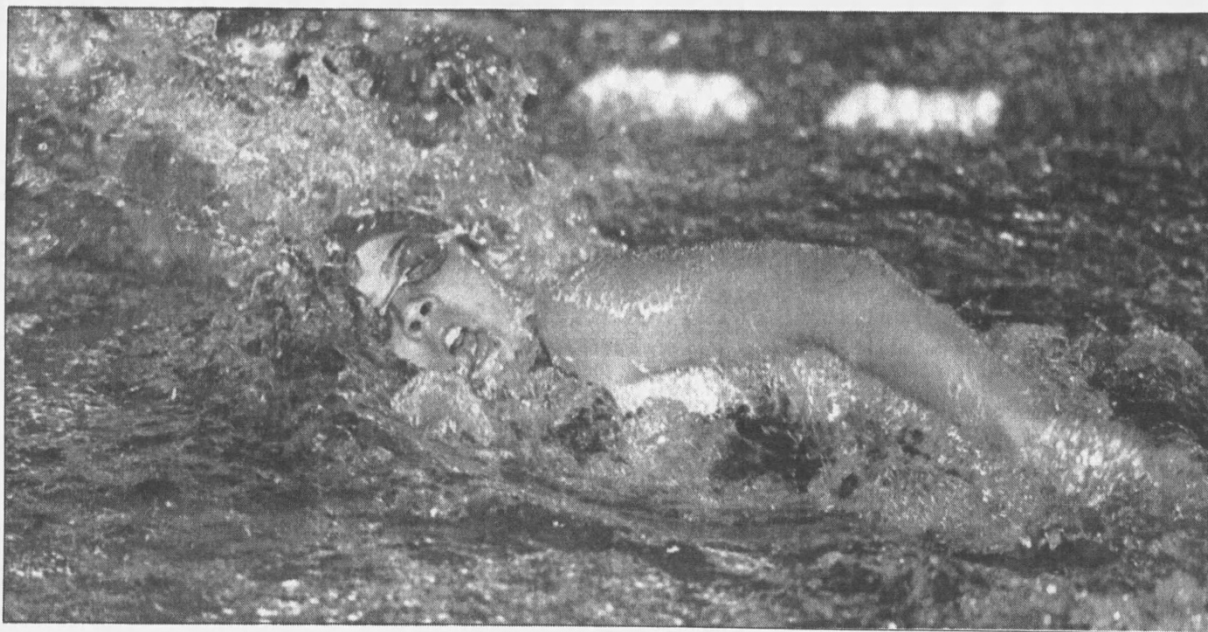
