

At the Division I tournament in Sandusky, Fremont Ross's Malcolm Leake was the lone Little Giant to advance to districts. It will be Leake's third-straight season in the district tournament.

Leake, the No. 2 seed who finished second at the final Greater Buckeye Conference Tournament, earned a first round bye, before dispensing of Mansfield Senior's Jon Goldman 6-0, 6-0 in the second round. He earned a berth in the semifinals then with a 6-0, 6-1 victory over Ashland's Josh Dancer.

Mansfield Madison's Austin Hammett, the No. 3 seed, will be Leake's semifinal opponent Saturday.
