

Driftmyer Draws Undeclared Foe

Fremont Ross' Gary Driftmyer drew an unbeaten opponent for his first match of the district tennis tournament Saturday at Toledo university. Driftmyer will face Ken Andryc, Toledo DeVilbiss, who was unseeded despite a 13-0 record during the regular season.

Some of his victories were on number two court and not number one court, so a DeVilbiss teammate Craig Burkhardt, 12-0, was seeded.

Rick DeLuca, Bellevue, the other Sandusky sectional singles representative, drew Gary Lea, Bowsher, as his first opponent. The drawings were conducted in Toledo Tuesday night.

Jim Bright, Lima, member of the defending district doubles championship team with a 13-2 record was top-seeded in singles.

Sandusky Sectional winners Chris and John Amato, Norwalk St. Paul, were top seeded and drew a first round bye. They will meet the Mansfield team of Jim Connes and Nelson Whisler in the second round.
